SNURGE RETIRED Snurge (IRE) (Ela-Mana-Mou {IRE}), the highest-earning European-based horse in history, has been retired after sustaining an injury. The seven-year-old horse, winner of Doncaster's 1990 St. Leger and promoted to first following his second-place finish to Wiorno in the 1992 Rothmans International at Woodbine, amassed £1,326,704 in worldwide prize money. However, he hurt a heel when trailing the field in last month's Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot and was reported to be "very, very sore" on his return home. No details of any position at stud have so far been revealed. Snurge was the Champion Stayer in Italy in 1991, as well as the highweight older horse in England and France at 14 furlongs and up. He won seven stakes and was placed in 15 others. "Snurge's record speaks for itself," said his trainer Paul Cole. "He was a durable racehorse who always ran his heart out. I am sure he will be a great success as a stallion."

GO FOR GIN LIKELY FOR BREEDERS' CUP Kentucky Derby winner **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) is a likely starter in the Breeders' Cup Classic, trainer Nick Zito reported yesterday morning. Zito had said earlier he was probably going to pass the race because of Go For Gin's dull performance in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, in which he finished last. The final decision will be made after the three-year-old's next workout. He will not, however, have regular rider Chris McCarron aboard for the race. McCarron informed Zito yesterday that he has chosen European shipper **Cezanne (GB)** (Ajdal) for the Classic. Zito will use Jerry Bailey in his place. Bailey became available when Mike Smith was given the mount on **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), which he gave up before the Woodward to ride Holy Bull. "I know it sounds like a broken record at this point, but this horse really is doing well," said Zito. "He's passed all the tests we have given him with flying colors."

NEW O'BRIEN AT BALLYDOYLE Aidan

O'Brien, reigning champion National Hunt trainer in Ireland, is set to take over the Ballydoyle facilities of his namesake Vincent. The 25-year-old Aidan, no relation to the world-famous handler of such great colts as El Gran Senor, Sir Ivor and Nijinsky II, will move into the main stable on the Coolmore-owned Tipperary estate in November. "I will be taking between 25 and 30 yearlings to Ballydoyle," he said. "They will be trained there along with some yearlings owned by the Coolmore syndicate. Next year I will have a few of my older flat horses based there too. My operation will be divided between my own place at Owing (in Kilkenny) and Ballydoyle, which I can reach in less than half an hour." Vincent O'Brien, who announced his retirement just two weeks ago, will continue to live at Ballydoyle but is not expected to have another runner as a trainer.

FASIG-TIPTON KENTUCKY FALL YEARLING SALE RESULTS Fasig-Tipton Kentucky held its Fall Yearling Sale Monday, with 242 yearlings bringing a total of \$2,035,200 and an average of \$8,410.

There were 35 horses reported as unsold. The sales topper at \$57,000 was a dark bay or brown filly by Lyphard--Querida (IRE) (Habitat). A half-sister to stakes winners Quintillion (IRE) (Rusticaro), Kirov Premiere (GB) (Sadler's Wells) and Theatre Critic (IRE) (Sadler's Wells), the filly was consigned to the sale by Ashford Stud, agent, and purchased by John T.L. Jones, Jr.

SECOND PURSE INCREASE AT THE

MEADOWLANDS Thoroughbred purses at The Meadowlands will be increased for the second time this meeting, it was announced yesterday by Michael P. Dempsey, Racing Secretary and Director of Racing for The Meadowlands. "Effective immediately, nightly purses will be raised an average of eight percent," Dempsey said. "This means we will be offering an estimated \$182,000 per card, the highest daily average in Meadowlands thoroughbred history." Purses were already raised 10 percent September 26 of the current meet.

CONTE DI SAVOYA TO STUD Stakes-winning and track record-setting **Conte Di Savoya** (Sovereign Dancer) has been retired from racing, according to owner Jaime S. Carrion. Winning from 6 1/2-furlongs to 1 1/8-miles, Conte Di Savoya earned \$402,931. A \$380,000 yearling, he is the first foal out of MGSW Funistrada (by Fappiano) and is from the immediate Tartan family of champion Cozzene. Conte Di Savoya will stand for \$3,500 live foal at Fred Seitz's Brookdale Farm as the property of Jaime Carrion and Brookdale Farm.
