FLAWLESSLY RETIRED Two-time Eclipse Award winner **Flawlessly** (Affirmed) has been retired and will be bred next spring. The six-year-old mare heads to the breeding shed with a career record of 16 wins, nine of them Grade I stakes, and \$2,572,536 in earnings. The champion turf mare made her last start August 27 at Arlington, finishing second by a half-length to Hatoof in the GI Beverly D. S.; her last victory came in Del Mar's GI Ramona H. August 6.

SAM-SON OWNERS DONATE \$5 MILLION TO CANCER TREATMENT CENTER A \$5 million (Canadian) donation from owner/breeder Ernie Samuel and his wife Elizabeth has assured the completion of a radiation therapy center in a new Toronto cancer treatment facility for 1995. The donation is the largest ever for Toronto's Princess Margaret Hospital. The Samuels, involved in racing for over 20 years, own Sam-Son Farm, which has produced champions Sky Classic and Dance Smartly, the leading distaff money earner of all time. "We were going to make the donation in our wills," said Samuel, 64, "but we became concerned about people being diagnosed with cancer who have to wait long periods for treatment, or have to leave the province to get it. We figured we might as well get on with it and give the money to the hospital now, when they need it most."

MOONAX HEADS TO ROYAL OAK St. Leger winner **Moonax** (Caerleon), scratched from the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in favor of stablemate Richard Of York, will make his next start in the GI Prix Royal Oak at Longchamp Sunday. He will face the top two from the Prix du Cadran, **Molesnes** (Alleged) and **Always Earnest** (Alleged).

News: Nine Breeders' Cup runners arrived at Churchill Wednesday, headed by '93 Distaff champ **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) and top rival **Sky Beauty** (Blushing Groom {Fr}). Flying in for the Classic were **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony), and **Flag Down** (Deputy Minister), who finished third to Colonial Affair in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, his dirt debut. A shipment of California contenders is expected Friday, including last year's Sprint winner, **Cardmania** (Cox's Ridge). The gelding finished fourth in the GIII Ancient Title Breeders' Cup last Saturday following a nine-month layoff for a fractured cannon bone; with only six Breeders' Cup points in '94, however, the eight-year-old will have to be invited to the race. Two other West Coast sprinters, **Saratoga Gambler** (Saratoga Six) and **Concept Win** (Manila), first and third respectively in the Ancient Title, are also looking for invitations to the race. "The selections are made subjectively...it depends on who's the 'now' horse," said Saratoga Gambler's trainer Bill Spawr, whose Music Merci made the list last year and finished sixth.

Owner Frank Stronach has paid \$1 million for **Only Royale (Ire)** (Caerleon), a five-year-old mare who will be pointed for the Turf. A two-time winner of the GI Yorkshire Oaks and highweight older mare in England last year from 11-14 furlongs, she was seventh in the GI Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last time out. Frankie Dettori will have the mount. Stronach will also be represented by **Basqueian** (Bounding Basque) (Classic), **Honky Tonk Tune** (Cure the Blues) (Juvenile Fillies) and **King Ruckus** (Bold Ruckus) (Sprint).

On Tap: Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who already has two of the top Juvenile Fillies runners in **Flanders** (Seeking the Gold) and **Serena's Song** (Rahy), will send out two more possibles in Saturday's GII Alcibiades S. at Keeneland, **Lilly Capote** (Capote) and **Cat Appeal** (Storm Cat). A good performance will make Lilly Capote a definite for the race; as Cat Appeal runs for Overbrook Farm, the same owner as Flanders, she may skip the race. Even if all four go, it will not be a record for Lukas, who sent out five for the '87 and '88 Juvenile Fillies.

Workouts: **Megan's Interco** (Interco) (Mile) went five furlongs in :59 4/5 under jockey Corey Black at Santa Anita Thursday; he is set to ship to Churchill with stablemate **Grand Flotilla** (Caro {Ire}) (Turf) Friday.

HUSBAND INJURED IN ROTHMANS Husband (Diesis {GB}), winner of last year's GI Rothmans International and beaten only a length and three-quarters when fourth this year off a five-month layoff, suffered a fractured splint bone in the race and will be on the sidelines for about six weeks. The lightly raced four-year-old, winless in just three starts since taking the '93 Rothmans, has been shipped to Keswick Stables in Virginia, where he will have the splint bone surgically removed. Following his recuperation, he will be sent to trainer W. J. Hirsch Jr. and prepared for an American campaign.

TOP ENGLISH 'CHASER TO COMPETE IN COLONIAL CUP

Crystal Spirit (Kris {GB}), a three-time winner last year and a good third in the Cheltenham Festival's Sun Alliance 'Chase in March, is to challenge for the Colonial Cup at Camden, South Carolina November 11. The seven-year-old, who will make his first appearance since spring in next Wednesday's Harry E. Perry Handicap 'Chase at Cheltenham, is owned by Paul Mellon. "The main appeal (of the Colonial Cup) is that Mr. Mellon will be able to go to Camden to see him run, as he is unable to visit Britain these days," said trainer Ian Balding. Long-term plans for the 'chaser include another British campaign and a possible crack at the Cheltenham Gold Cup.

6th-KEE, \$22,312, Alw, 2yo, a7f, 1:27 4/5, my. CURE THE JINX (c, 2, Cure the Blues--Baby Jinx, by Crafty Prospector) unplaced while racing in stakes company since breaking his maiden in July at Calder, profited from the drop in class to register an off-the-pace neck win at 5-1.
