PURSES UP AT OAK TREE The Oak Tree Racing Association increased its overnight purse distribution approximately 10 percent across the board Wed., retroactive to the first day of the meet. Oak Tree officials cited the success of unrestricted north-south simulcasting and interstate simulcasting for the raise, which will amount to approximately \$250,000 daily.

BOB'S RETURN RETIRED The '93 Donacaster St. Leger winner **Bob's Return** (Bob Back) has run his last race. The 4-year-old sustained an injury when finishing 5th in last month's Jefferson Smurfit Memorial Irish St. Leger. Trainer Mark Tompkins said Friday, "He came back from Ireland with slight damage to his off-fore, and the owners and I feel the time is right to retire him." Bob's Return was 5-for-14, winning more than \$580,000 in purses.

NEW YORK HORSEMEN CONSIDER WHIP RULE Horsemen at NYRA tracks are considering the introduction of an experiment to limit the number of times a horse may be hit with a whip during a race, according to a report in yesterday's *New York Post*. Set in place for a 2-month trial during the upcoming winter meeting, the experiment would limit the number of strokes to 12, the *Post* reported. "I think the majority of trainers think the jockeys whip too much as it is," trainer and NY-HBPA board member Dennis Brida told the paper after a meeting with his colleagues. "There have been restrictions in Europe for a long time and it's about time we stood up for ourselves." Last year, California instituted changes in their rules governing the use of the whip, not limiting the number of strokes but disallowing jockeys from striking horses on any part of the body other than the shoulders and hindquarters. Jockeys in England are limited to 5 strokes of the whip; in Sweden, riders must keep their hands on the reins when they use the whip; in Norway, jockeys are prohibited from striking horses with a whip.

Three-year-old **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold) (Classic), winner of the GII Molson Million and runner-up to Bertrando in the GII Goodwood H., was not on the plane from California yesterday; trainer David Hofmans has made new plans to send his runner on a flight next Wednesday, but the final decision on the colt's Breeders' Cup status will be made by owner John Mabee. "I told Mr. Mabee I wanted to take the horse, and now it's up to him," said Hofmans.

GI Meadowlands Cup winner **Conveyor** (Sharpen Up {GB}) has been shipped to Churchill and will be pointed for the Classic.

Workouts: Lakeway (Seattle Slew) (Distaff) worked a brisk seven furlongs in 1:24 2/5, handily, at Hollywood Park Friday. The time was five seconds faster than the next best work at the distance on the tab. Jockey Kent Desormeaux, who did not ride Thursday or Friday due to a bout with the flu, did get up out of his sick bed to pilot the filly for the work.
