COLONIAL AFFAIR INJURED,

RETIRED Centennial Farms' **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony), winner of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and the 1993 Belmont S., broke a sesamoid bone in his right rear leg in a stall accident early Saturday, said his trainer Scotty Schulhofer Sunday morning from Churchill Downs. The injury will end the four-year-old's racing career, the trainer added. According to Schulhofer, Colonial Affair became agitated after the arrival of some other horses and kicked the back wall of his stall. "There was a filling in the leg Saturday morning," he continued. "We had it x-rayed and it showed the sesamoid was broken." Schulhofer said he was very confident Colonial Affair, who earned \$1.6 million in a racing career that included seven victories in 20 starts, could have won the Breeders' Cup Classic, to be run at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. "He's never been better in his life," Schulhofer said. "I felt like he could go out and get the job done. He loved the track and he had been galloping like a champion."

BEST PAL TO BREEDERS' CUP? Golden Eagle Farm's **Best Pal** (*Habitony) could head to Churchill Downs for the November 5 \$3 million Breeders' Cup Classic. "We're not ruling it out," said Golden Eagle Farm Racing Manager Gayle Van Leer at Santa Anita Sunday morning. "But pre-entries will be taken tomorrow (Monday) and obviously more will be known then." Best Pal would have to be supplemented to the Classic at a cost of \$360,000. With the winner to receive 60 percent of the purse, Best Pal would stand to earn roughly \$1.5 million should he win. "A win by Best Pal would put him within reach of the all-time (money) leaders," Van Leer added. To date, the six-year-old gelding has earned \$5,005,645, making him the third all-time money earner behind Alysheba and John Henry. Third in the Kentucky Cup Classic in his most recent effort, Best Pal was supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Classic last year. He finished 10th.

CLASSIC:

Kentucky Derby winner **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) arrived at Churchill Downs 5 a.m. Sunday. The three-year-old, who arrived from New York by van, drilled an impressive six furlongs Friday at Belmont in 1:12 3/5 with Classic jockey Jerry Bailey aboard. **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag) breezed six furlongs in 1:15 Sunday at Churchill Downs. **Bertrando** (Skywalker), second in last year's Classic, covered five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 over Hollywood Park's fast main track Sunday morning. He is scheduled to ship to Kentucky November 1. Burt Bacharach's **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms) (Classic) worked seven furlongs in a bullet 1:25 4/5 handily at Santa Anita Sunday morning.

JUVENILE:

Heading the work tab at Churchill Downs Sunday morning were trainer Ron McAnally's two juvenile prospects, both ridden by jockey Aaron Gryder. **On Target** (Forty Niner) and **Mr. Purple** (Deputy Minister), worked six and seven furlongs respectively. The former clocked 1:14, galloping out seven furlongs in 1:29. Mr. Purple was caught in 1:29 3/5. "They both went fine," said McAnally. "We didn't ask them for much."

JUVENILE FILLIES:

Ron McAnally trainee **Call Now** (Wild Again) worked six furlongs in 1:13 yesterday at Churchill Downs. Breezing Saturday at Churchill was **Stormy Blues** (Cure The Blues), who went a half-mile in :51.

SPRINT:

D'hallavant (Ogygian) breezed five-eighths in 1:04 yesterday morning at Churchill; **American Chance** (Cure The Blues) covered the same distance Saturday in 1:02.

DISTAFF:

Defending Distaff champion **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) didn't make yesterday's work tab, but trainer Neil Drysdale said, "She went an easy half-mile. I'm estimating :49 4/5 or :50. She's doing very well."

TURF/MILE:

Johann Quatz (FR) (Sadler's Wells), heading for either the Mile or the Turf, worked six furlongs in 1:16 Sun. at Churchill Downs with jockey Aaron Gryder up.
