Laffit Pincay Jr. will ride **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) in the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Classic, trainer Nick Zito announced yesterday. "Anytime you get the chance to get someone who's in the movies, you take it," said Zito. "We have a jockey to ride the horse who has great credentials." Pincay is also scheduled to ride **Exchange** (Explodent) in the Breeders' Cup Distaff and **Ocean Crest** (Storm Bird) in the Mile.

BREEDERS' CUP WORKOUTS

Jockey Corey Black flew in to Churchill Downs Wednesday morning from his Southern California base to work a pair of Jenine Sahadi-trained Breeders' Cup candidates. Turf-bound **Grand Flotilla** (Caro {IRE}) put in a sharp six furlong work in 1:14 4/5, galloping out seven furlongs in 1:28 4/5. **Megan's Interco** (Interco), prepping for the Mile, covered the same distance in 1:17. "I'm very happy with the way they both worked," said Sahadi. "I wanted them just to go easy. This is not the same track they're used to at home (Santa Anita)." Also on the work tab were **Strong Ally** (Tremolino) (Juvenile), who went seven furlongs in 1:31 3/5, and **Meritocrat** (On to Glory) (Sprint), who drilled six panels in 1:13 1/5. Three Breeders' Cup contenders worked at Belmont yesterday. They were **Cherokee Run** (Runaway Groom) (Sprint), five furlongs in a bullet :59; **Paradise Creek** (Irish River {FR}) (Turf), five furlongs on the turf, dogs up, in 1:05 2/5 breezing; **Fraise** (Strawberry Road {AUST}) (Turf), seven furlongs on the turf in 1:29 2/5 handily.

LOCHSONG PREPARES FOR AMERICAN RACING

Lochsong (GB) (Song {GB}), winner of the Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp earlier this month, is apparently in equally good form for her Breeders' Cup Sprint bid Nov. 5. The six-year-old mare travelled from trainer Ian Balding's stable at Kingsclere to Robert Sangster's nearby Manton complex Wednesday morning to gain some experience of working around a bend on an artificial surface. Jockey Frankie Dettori was delighted with the way Lochsong came through her workout. He said, "She's in excellent shape and handled the curves well. I was really pleased with her."

Pre-entries: A record 126 horses, including 33 from Europe, have been pre-entered for the 1994 Breeders' Cup, breaking the mark of 116 set in 1991. In races oversubscribed with more than 14 horses, the top eight Breeders' Cup point earners gain automatic berths. The remaining six horses will be selected by the Breeders' Cup Racing Directors/Secretaries panel. Horses not selected into the field are listed in preference order and, should there be a defection from the body of the field, horses will fill any vacancies in the order of ranking until the time of entry, Wed. Nov. 2, at 10 a.m. when post positions are drawn.

PETIT LOUP RETIRED TO STUD Petit Loup (Danzig), fourth to Paradise Creek in the Arlington Million in August, has been retired to the Haras du Quesnay in France. The five-year-old, winner of his first four starts this year including the G1 Gp Di Milano in Italy, was the 1992 Horse of the Year, Champion Three-Year-Old, Champion Grass Horse and Champion Stayer in Spain. A full brother to successful North American third-crop sire Ascot Knight, Petit Loup will stand for a fee of 25,000 francs.

JESUS BRACHO TO GIVE UP ECLIPSE

AWARD Jesus Bracho, the 1992 Eclipse Award-winning apprentice jockey, has settled his dispute with the state of Florida. As part of an agreement reached Wednesday, Oct. 26, Bracho agreed to give back his Eclipse Award and, in return, the state's Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering has agreed to reinstate Bracho's licenses so he can begin riding January 1, 1995. Bracho's dispute with the state came about because of a ruling handed down by the Calder stewards Nov. 2, 1993, in which he was found to have provided false documentation in regards to his riding record from Venezuela. The stewards recommended a 60-day suspension, the maximum allowed, and recommended that Bracho's license be revoked from any further racing indefinitely. At the time of his hearing Bracho said an official from the Venezuelan Jockey Club told him he didn't have to report many of his wins in that country. Of the six other Venezuelan jockeys suspended for the same reason, Eibar Coa, Teofilo Perdomo, Douglas Portillo and Olaf Hernandez are still serving suspensions. Jose Bolivar and Manuel Cordero have served their time and are riding again.

AVERAGE UP AT BARRETT'S FALL MIXED

SALE Barretts Equine Ltd. held its 1994 Fall Sale of Horses of All Ages Oct. 24-25 at Fairplex Park in Pomona, California. There were 361 horses sold for a total of \$2,104,800 and an average of \$5,830, up 15 percent from the 1993 average of \$5,070. The sales topper was **Valdemosa (ARG)**, a 10-year-old gray mare by Ringaro--Val D'isere (ARG) (Utopico {ARG}). A MG3 winner in Argentina and SW in North America, Valdemosa, consigned to the sale by Brad Martin and Katherine Griffiths, agent, was purchased by Luis F. Bouza, agent, for \$340,000. In foal to Bertrando, she is the producer of Time Star (Manila), winner of this year's G1 Italian Derby. The top priced weanling at \$100,000 was a bay colt by Broad Brush--Mori (ARG) (Lefty). Also offered by the sale's top consignor Brad Martin and Katherine Griffiths, agent, the colt was purchased by the sale's leading purchaser, Luis F. Bouza, agent.

TATTERSALLS SECOND SESSION RESULTS

There were 199 lots sold at the second session of the Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sales, held Tuesday at Newmarket. The session's gross was 2,794,050 guineas, averaging 14,040 guineas per horse. This represents an 8.9 percent decrease from last year's second session average of 15,415 guineas. Highest price of 100,000 guineas was brought by **Captain Jack (GB)**, a four-year-old bay gelding by Salse--Sanctuary (Welsh Pageant). A winner of four races in 1994, Captain Jack is a half-brother to Sheikh Albadou (GB), Europe's Champion Sprinter in 1992. He was consigned to the sale by Bedford House Stables and purchased by Clive Smith. The sale concludes Thursday.
