LAKEWAY OUT INDEFINITELY Trainer Gary Jones said yesterday that **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew), who will miss the Breeders' Cup Distaff due to a recurrence of pus in her respiratory tract, will leave Southern California for Kentucky November 1 to recover. "I don't know how long she'll be out," Jones said. "Until they get it cleaned up." The three-year-old filly won four Grade I events this year for earnings to date of \$594,520. In her most recent start, she finished second to **Heavenly Prize** (Seeking The Gold) in the August 13 GI Alabama S. at Saratoga, after which her respiratory ailment was discovered.

BREEDERS' CUP NEWS There were only two Breeders' Cup workouts Thurs. morning at Churchill Downs. Distaff-bound **One Dreamer** (Relaunch) went seven furlongs in 1:29 3/5, while Juvenile Fillies contender **Stormy Blues** (Cure The Blues) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 1/5. "She went very nice," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer of Stormy Blues. Arlington Million winner and early Turf favorite **Paradise Creek** (Irish River {FR}) is scheduled to fly into Louisville today. Rothman's Int'l winner **Raintrap** (GB) (Rainbow Quest) (Turf) is also scheduled on that same flight from New York, along with **Dominant Prospect** (Fortunate Prospect) (Mile). Arriving from California today will be Classic hopefuls **Bertrando** (Skywalker) and **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o' Gold). That flight will make a stopover in Oklahoma City to pick up Sunday's Mathis Brothers Remington Futurity winner **Evansville Slew** (Slew City Slew), headed for the Juvenile.

DESERT MIRAGE FRACTURES SESAMOID

Desert Mirage (Skywalker), a sharp second to **Supremo** (Gone West) in the Gil Norfolk S. at Santa Anita Oct. 9 and second by a neck to early Breeders' Cup Juvenile favorite **Timber Country** (Woodman) in the Gill Balboa S. at Del Mar in August, fractured his right front sesamoid bone and underwent surgery Thursday, trainer Jim Buss reported yesterday. "The exercise rider said he shied away from a red tarp on the turf course while he was galloping out after a workout," said Buss, who was preparing Desert Mirage for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile when the injury occurred. "It's sad, because he had been doing so well," Buss continued. "I thought he had a big shot in the Breeders' Cup."
