NUMBERS UP AT KEENELAND FALL MEET

Both the on-track attendance and total handle at the 16-day 1994 Keeneland Fall meet which concluded yesterday showed increases over last year's figures. A total of 216,359 racing fans visited the track during the '94 season, up 12.5 percent over 1993; the daily average attendance of 13,522 was also 12.5 higher than last year. Total handle rose 6 percent, from \$39,434,017 a year ago to \$40,787,699, a record for the meet. The total daily average for the meet was a record \$2,611,731, also up 6 percent from '93. Total on-track handle, \$19,894,725, and the average daily on-track handle, \$1,243,420, showed an increase of 6.9 percent. Pat Day led all riders with 17 victories; D. Wayne Lukas and Carl Nafzger tied in the trainer standings with 10 apiece; and John Oxley and Overbrook Farm led the owners with four each.

MAKTOUM EXPANDS STABLE Trainers Andre Fabre, Barry Hills and Mark Johnston are all set to benefit significantly from a change in policy by Maktoum al Maktoum. Each will be receiving their first batch of yearlings from the Dubai Sheikh this winter. Hills is to get six, Johnston will take five and Fabre will have three, including Nijinsky's last foal, who is out of the champion It's In The Air.

APPROACH THE BENCH RETIRED GISW **Approach The Bench** (Ire) (Law Society), winner of seven races and \$688,767, has been retired and will stand at Meadow Court Stud in Ireland for 1995. The six-year-old made his last start in the GI Oak Tree Invitational October 9, finishing third.
