**Turf:** **Grand Flotilla** (Caro {Ire}) will not make it to the Breeders' Cup due to a fever which cost him valuable training time. Said trainer Jenine Sahadi, "He had a slight temperature; I had the doctor do some blood work and he showed an elevated white count. I've lost two days of training on him. He hasn't missed a meal, he's been going out morning and afternoon, grazing and bucking and feeling good, but obviously he had a little infection. I'm disappointed, but he's been a really good horse for me and I don't want to run him and have it knock him out." If all goes well, the colt will make his next start in the Japan Cup.

**Classic:** Eclipse winner **Bertrando** (Skywalker), a \$360,000 supplement, worked six furlongs at Churchill yesterday in 1:17 3/5. He will try to improve on his second-place finish in the race a year ago.

**Distaff:** Defending champ **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) went an easy five furlongs in 1:04 over the Churchill strip Sunday. "She's coming into the race well," said trainer Neil Drysdale of the filly, who won the Debutante S. over the Louisville oval as a two-year-old.

**Juvenile:** Norfolk S. winner **Supremo** (Gone West) went six furlongs in 1:15 at Churchill, while **Sea Emperor** (Naked Sky) went a sharp five-eighths in 1:01 at Calder. The winner of the In Reality S., part of the Florida Stallion Series, will ship to Kentucky today.

**Juvenile Fillies:** **Mama Mucci** (Regal Classic) worked five furlongs at Churchill in 1:01 3/5, galloping out six furlongs in 1:15 and seven-eighths in 1:30. "I was pleased with the way she finished," said trainer Mike Orman. Trainer Ron Allen was disappointed in his filly's move yesterday; Alcibiades S. winner **Post It** (Notebook) went six furlongs in 1:19 3/5. Said Allen, "She was either not getting hold of the track, or it was cupping out too much. She's usually a good worker. Maybe she just didn't have a good day." Down at Calder, **Fortune Pending** (Fortunate Prospect) breezed five furlongs in 1:02. The Florida-bred will accompany Sea Emperor on the van to Churchill today; she will try to become the second filly to prep for this race with a win in the Florida Stallion Series, following Brave Raj (1986).

The favorite, Itaka, made a run at the leader down the lane but had to settle for second.
