## BREEDERS' CUP XI: A ROLLER

**COASTER RIDE** Breeders' Cup XI featured the thrill of victory, the agony of defeat...and the agony of watching a champion loaded into the horse ambulance after a gallant victory. **Flanders** (Seeking the Gold) stamped herself a true champion with her heroic victory over game stablemate **Serena's Song** (Rahy); but before the crowd could catch it's breath after the inspiring stretch run, jockey Pat Day had jumped off the winner and the ambulance was on the way to the clubhouse turn. "I didn't notice anything wrong until we were pulling up," said Day. "She was stinging a little bit and she was noticeably off. I got off her as quickly as possible." X-rays revealed a fractured right front cannon bone and sesamoid, which will require surgery and could compromise the filly's career. Jockey Mike Smith had a ride on the Breeders' Cup XI roller coaster as well. Smith's Breeder's Cup began with sweet success in the Sprint as favored **Cherokee Run** (Runaway Groom) caught **Soviet Problem** (Moscow Ballet) to give the rider a record 63 stakes wins on the year. Said trainer Frank Alexander, "The race couldn't have gone better. It went exactly the way I wanted it to unfold." Smith's day began to unravel just two races later, when second choice **Sky Beauty** (Blushing Groom {Fr}) failed to handle the Churchill strip and came home last in the Distaff. Favored **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) also struggled and could do no better than sixth behind the day's biggest surprise, **One Dreamer** (Relaunch). But the longest drop for Smith was to come in the Mile. Going for an unprecedented third Breeders' Cup win with **Lure** (Danzig), the nation's leading rider was able to overcome the far outside post to take up position in midpack, but for the first time in 18 starts on the grass, Lure failed to fire and ended up ninth. "I'm at a loss for words," Smith said after the race. Winning jockey Frankie Dettori, earning his first Breeders' Cup victory, was not. After leaping off the victorious **Barathea** (Sadler's Wells) in a tribute to hero Angel Cordero Jr., Dettori said, "It is very tough for the Europeans to come here and win. This is the best feeling in the world." Team Lukas was back on top of the world for the Juvenile; **Timber Country** (Woodman) lived up to his press and assured his stable another Eclipse.

Concern, who had settled for the minor awards while finishing in the money his last seven starts, put it together when it really counted, flying by the entire field to catch the leaders in deep stretch, and refusing to relinquish the lead once he'd gotten it; the win gave jockey Jerry Bailey his third Classic triumph. "He runs very hard every time and if the race sets up right and I don't mess it up, he'll get there," said Bailey. Said trainer Dick Small, "This horse is explosive. He's got incredible acceleration. Broad Brush had it, too. Some horses pick it up gradually; this horse just explodes." Small added that the colt would be pointed to the Strub series this winter. The favorite, Tabasco Cat, put a head in front inside the eighth pole but could not hold off the winner. **DEVIL HIS DUE** (Devil's Bag), the second choice, was never in the hunt and finished 11th. "He didn't like the race-track at all," said rider Mike Smith. "He never got a hold of it for one second."

"The sun is going to shine; I can feel it," said a beaming D. Wayne Lukas, who expects big things in the future for his Juvenile winner. "I have always been his biggest cheerleader. He's a big horse; I believe all of his best races are ahead of him." While Timber Country's team can look forward to a strong three-year-old campaign, the connections of Turf star **Paradise Creek** (Irish River {Fr}) were hoping to see their champ end his remarkable season on a winning note, possibly challenging Holy Bull's claim to Horse of the Year honors. The five-year-old did not disgrace himself finishing third, but his chance at racing's highest accolade is gone. It was jockey Pat Day, who earned his second '94 Breeders' Cup win aboard Timber Country, who tasted bitter defeat, while Mike Smith was riding high again, booting home Turf winner **Tikkanen** (Cozzene) for owner George Strawbridge. "This is the thrill of our racing life," said Strawbridge. "Let me say, winning is extraordinary. I am numb...sheer ecstasy." Owner/breeder Robert Meyerhoff and trainer Dick Small had their opportunity to savor the Breeders' Cup experience in the day's finale as **Concern** (Broad Brush), who had vanned into Kentucky only the day before, made another late run but arrived at the wire right on time to take the Classic over **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat). A storybook ending would have had the Cat, notorious for the accident that nearly took Jeff Lukas' life last year, striding under the wire on top as Jeff cheered him home. "I was so pleased with the day, but we wanted this one more than the others," said D. Wayne Lukas. But, looking towards next year, the elder Lukas added, "Somewhere, there is a Classic win out there for us."

Following in the hoofsteps of sire Cozzene, the 1985 Mile winner, Tikkanen visited the States for the second time and came away with a second victory. The Turf Classic winner was allowed to trail the field behind rapid early fractions, but he came flying at the finish, passing favored Paradise Creek and holding the late-running Hatoof safe to give Mike Smith his second Breeders' Cup win of the day. "He ran a tremendous race," said Smith, who was riding the colt in competition for the first time. "We just let them duke it out in front of us, then I asked him to run. It was a great pick-up mount."

Sent off the 5-2 choice, Timber Country did not disappoint, finding an opening along the rail at the top of the stretch and bursting through for his second straight GI score. "This is going to be a nice colt," said winning rider Pat Day. "You are going to hear a lot from him. He's very professional." European Eltish, making his first start on the dirt, closed to take the lead briefly before succumbing to the winner. Tejano Run and ON TARGET (Forty Niner), who both had trouble early in the race, came running late to gain a piece of the purse while failing to threaten the top two.

Sent off the second choice among the Europeans, Baratheia atoned for his fifth-place finish after blowing the first turn in the Mile a year ago, going around both bends like a hoop around a barrel and galloping clear in the stretch run to set a new course record. "He's one of the best milers there has been for a long, long time," said trainer Luca Cumani. "Today he had all the luck he deserved, which for many of his races he hasn't." The disappointment in the race this year was two-time winner LURE (Danzig), who found good position from his post 14 but could not take advantage of it, coming up empty in the drive and finishing ninth. "He just kind of went through the motions today," said a dejected Mike Smith. "I think somebody grabbed him on the backside because he went down behind; he came back, but he just didn't have it today."

In a Breeders' Cup shocker, the three favorites went down to defeat as outsider One Dreamer led the field from flagfall to finish and left just enough in the tank to hold off third choice Heavenly Prize to stun the crowd and pay \$96.20. The six-year-old was overlooked by the bettor's despite having finished on the board in 19 of her 24 career starts. "I know she has a fondness for this racetrack," said trainer Tom Proctor, who could not resist taking a bow as he escorted his mare back to the test barn. "She came up here off a race in Florida and we've been planning this race ever since." Hollywood Wildcat pressed the pace for a quarter before fading to sixth. "The mare just didn't handle the racetrack at all," said her rider, Eddie Delahoussaye. "It was cupping out under her. She's still a great filly; it just wasn't her day." Sky Beauty suffered her first defeat of the year, showing little early and ending up last. "I wanted to be two lengths back at most," said her jockey, Mike Smith. "I don't know what to make of it--I couldn't get her to go, even down the backstretch. She just couldn't get a hold of the racetrack from the word go."

**Juvenile Fillies cont.**

Tested for the first time, Flanders proved herself a true champion, outgaming stablemate Serena's Song in a furious stretch drive to remain undefeated and assure herself an Eclipse Award. The courageous performance was not without its price, however, as the filly pulled up lame and had to be vanned back to the barn in an ambulance. Dr. Robert Copelan, who examined Flanders after the race, said, "She has a displaced condylar fracture of the right cannon bone with an axial fracture of the lateral sesamoid in the right front leg. It is repairable with bone screws. After she is operated on we'll know more relative to prognosis." Of the race, jockey Pat Day said, "This was a great race between two brilliant fillies. I don't want to take anything away from the second-place filly, but when I asked, the effort was there." Runner-up rider Corey Nakatani said, "My filly gave it everything she had, but she got a little tired." Said winning owner William T. Young, "Serena's Song challenged Flanders and she challenged me, too. I wasn't sure I'd make it through the finish. It was a real thrill."

- Becoming only the second favorite in Breeders' Cup history to win the Sprint, following inaugural winner Eillo, Cherokee Run made his way through the crowd from the back of the pack to catch the speedy Soviet Problem at the top of the stretch; from there it was a dogfight to the wire. The filly refused to give up, battling head and head down the long Churchill lane, but the :44 3/5 half took its toll in the final yards and an equally determined Cherokee Run prevailed in the photo. "I wasn't sure we would get by her," said winning jockey Mike Smith, who broke his own record for stakes wins in a year with the victory, notching number 63 for '94. "That filly just hung so tough. But my colt had just enough stamina to get by her." The result marked the first time supplemental entries have finished one-two in a Breeders' Cup race.
