BREEDERS' CUP WRAP-UP Juvenile Fillies winner **Flanders** (Seeking the Gold) was scheduled to undergo surgery yesterday; the two-year-old suffered a displaced condylar fracture of the right front cannon bone with an axial fracture of the lateral sesamoid. (Dr. Larry Bramlage and Dr. Robert Copelan) are going to go ahead and put the pin in there and pull it together," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "We'll give her recovery time, which she has coming anyway, and just take it from there." Lukas added that Juvenile champ **Timber Country** (Woodman) came out of the race in good order; he will prepare for the Triple Crown on the West Coast. "We'll get him back around the first of February and then race once a month to the Derby," he remarked. "I want him to come in fresh and be looking down the road." **Cherokee Run** (Runaway Groom), who looked like an Eclipse winner taking the Sprint, will not be retired as originally planned but will race again next year. The Sprint runner-up, **Soviet Problem** (Moscow Ballet) may make her next start in Japan, in the \$1.9 million Sprinter S. December 18. The third-place finisher in the race, **Cardmania** (Cox's Ridge), will be pointed to the Vernon O. Underwood H. at Hollywood December 10. The surprise winner of the Distaff, **One Dreamer** (Relaunch), set to go to the breeding shed next year, may run next in the GI Matriarch at Hollywood November 27. Her trainer, Tom Proctor, and trainer Dick Small, who saddled **Concern** (Broad Brush) to take the Classic, were both winning their first Breeders' Cup races with their first Breeders' Cup starters. Commenting on the Classic, Small said, "When Bertrando won in California, I was kind of hoping they would bite and supplement him. That guaranteed that there would be real speed up front." He added that his colt would start his four-year-old campaign in the Strub Series, with an eye towards the Pimlico Special and a repeat in the Classic at Belmont. **Sky Beauty** (Blushing Groom {Fr}), ninth in the Distaff, could also get the chance to try for a Breeders' Cup win in her own backyard. The four-year-old will run again in '95. Her stablemate **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), 11th in the Classic, will remain at Churchill Downs until the disposition of the dispute between his owner and the IRS. A judgement is due from Syracuse, New York, November 28.

Aube Indienne (Fr), who returned from a two-month layoff to take the GI Las Palmas H. at Santa Anita last time out, made it two in a row, finding running room on the far turn under jockey Kent Desormeaux to get the jump on longshot Fondly Remembered, who came late to nail Zoonaqu for second. "Last time she ran good, today she got lucky," said Desormeaux. "I had nowhere to go at the half-mile pole. Chris Antley (on Fondly Remembered) and I were jockeying for position. I got to sneak through and sneak off on him." Said Antley, "I was behind two horses; so was Kent, but he was able to slip through on the rail. I ended up following him out. By that time he probably had opened up a couple of lengths on me. I don't know if it made a difference or not...it could have." Winning trainer Charlie Whittingham, taking his fourth Yellow Ribbon, said, "This sure takes some of the sting out of losing Flawlessly. It's great now that we've got one that looks like she's going to help us some. She's just an honest filly and she had a good trip all the way."

KEENELAND NOVEMBER SALE OFF TO GOOD START Whiffing, the dam of 1993's Champion Three-Year-Old Colt Prairie Bayou, brought top price of \$1,050,000 at yesterday's first session of the 1994 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. A nine-year-old mare by Wavering Monarch--Queen's Gambit (Bold Ruler), Whiffing, in foal to Danzig, was consigned to the sale by Longfield Farm, Agent for the Loblolly Stable Dispersal and purchased by Henryk de Kwiatkowski's Calumet Farm. The second highest price of the session was brought by the five-year-old MGSW **November Snow**. An earner of \$547,338 to date, she was sold as a racing or broodmare prospect by Eaton-Williams, Agent for The Dissolution of Partnership Interests of Earle I. Mack and John Moran et al., and purchased by Fares Farm Inc. for \$700,000. Keeneland sold 129 horses yesterday for a total of \$13,410,700; the average of \$103,959 was up 25.8 percent from last year's first session average of \$82,627. The median price was \$67,000. The 10-day sale continues through November 15.

TRA AND JOCKEYS' GUILD STILL AT ODDS OVER BENEFITS Officials from the Thoroughbred Racing Associations met with members of the Jockeys' Guild yesterday at Churchill Downs, but the negotiating session failed to produce any movement toward a settlement in the on-going dispute over health and accident premiums for jockeys. The TRA made a proposal to the Guild, which the jockeys' organization termed "an insult." While the TRA says their proposal would increase jockeys' benefits across the board, the Guild's National Manager John Giovanni claims the plan would actually cut the package his members are now receiving. The current TRA/Jockeys' Guild contract expires December 31; a job action by the nation's riders is likely at that time if a new contract cannot be agreed upon. Giovanni is not confident the problems can be resolved in time to avoid a strike. The next negotiating session is set for November 15 in Chicago.

CATRAIL TO IRISH NATIONAL STUD Catrail (Storm Cat), officially rated Europe's three-year-old sprint champion of 1993, has been retired to stand at Ireland's National Stud. Winner of his only start as a juvenile, the colt collected five races last season but failed to score in three outings this year. The GSW was second in the Gil Prix Maurice de Gheest at the end of July. Catrail will be limited to 65 mares in 1995 and will stand for a fee of 9,000 Irish pounds.

STALCREEK RETIRED The 1994 La Canada winner **Stalcreek** (Stalwart) was injured in a recent breeze and has been retired from racing, according to trainer David Bernstein. The four-year-old will be bred to Storm Bird on a foal-sharing arrangement.

CALDER POSTS GAINS FOR '94 Calder Race Course concluded its 1994 meet Saturday with increases in attendance, on-track handle, intertrack and interstate handle, and total handle. The total handle, a record \$235,823,305 for a single Calder meeting, was up 18.3 percent from last year; the daily average total handle, over \$1.9 million, was a Calder record as well. Showing an increase for the first time since 1985, on-track attendance rose 3.3 percent for both the total, with 779,324 visiting the track during the 122-day season, and the daily average of 6,388. On-track handle was also up slightly, 1.1 percent higher than '93 figures. "This is a great start," said Calder President C. Kenneth Dunn. "The increases are a result of several years of gradual changes capped off by dramatic changes this year in our stakes schedule and marketing, and the response of the fans towards these events has been gratifying." Gary Boulanger led all jockeys at the meet with 152 winners, and Dan Hurtak topped the trainers with 45 victories. The leading owner was James Lewis, with 20 wins.
