DERBY WINNER BRINGS \$2 MILLION AT

KEENELAND Winning Colors (Caro {Ire}), one of only three fillies to win the Kentucky Derby, brought a top price of \$2 million Tuesday during the third session of Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale. Joss Collins signed the sales ticket in the name of BBA (England) for the nine-year-old broodmare, who is in foal to Storm Cat. Gainesway Thoroughbreds Ltd. and Peter Brant sold Winning Colors to "dissolve a joint venture." Second highest price for the day was \$1 million paid by Brushwood Stables for Hattab Gal (Al Hattab), a 13-year-old mare in foal to Deputy Minister. Consigned by Lonnie R. Owens' Katalpa Farm as agent, Hattab Gal is the dam of stakes winners Paper Princess, Sea Cadet and On Target. Keeneland sold 292 horses Tuesday for \$31,855,000, up 104 percent over the gross of \$15,584,200 brought in during last year's third session; the '94 average of \$109,092 was up 111 percent from 1993.

HOMEISTER AWARDED ECLIPSE The Thoroughbred Racing Association announced yesterday that jockey Rosemary Homeister has been named the 1992 Eclipse Award winner as the leading apprentice rider. The decision came when the three voting entities for the award, the TRA, the Daily Racing Form and the National Turf Writers' Association, elected to honor Homeister after the original winner, Jesus Bracho, was declared ineligible. As a result, Homeister becomes the first woman to receive the Eclipse as Outstanding Apprentice.

Correction: While the numbers in Tuesday's news item regarding the Fasig-Tipton Fall Mixed Sale were correct, the percentages were not. The Sale actually showed a 144 percent increase for the gross and a 96 percent increase for the average.

Special Broad, runner-up in the GIII Selima S. at Laurel in her most recent effort, shipped up from Maryland for her first foray into New York. Backed down to 5-2 as the second choice in the seven-horse field, the Meyerhoff homebred rallied strongly under jockey Julie Krone to wear down the 7-5 favorite Carson Creek in the drive. The bettors' choice, a five-length allowance winner at Keeneland last out making her stakes debut for Team Lukas, battled with CHRISTMAS CACTUS (Allen's Prospect) to the far turn, then dug in when challenged in the stretch but could not hold off the winner.
