TABASCO CAT TO HOLLYWOOD DERBY

MGISW **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), second in the Breeders' Cup Classic, will make his next start in the GI Hollywood Derby November 20. "He came out of the Classic in good shape," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. The race will mark the three-year-old's grass debut. "We've been wanting to get him on the grass," said Lukas. "I think his action and his foot indicate he'll have a good future on the grass. It will be interesting to see how he reacts, but I'm really excited about putting him on the grass." The colt will face a pair of European invaders in the race; trainer Andre Fabre will send French graded stakes winners **Fadaye** (Nureyev) and **Signe Divin** (Bering {GB}).

JULIE KRONE UNDERGOES SURGERY

Jockey Julie Krone underwent surgery yesterday to remove the two plates and 13 screws from her reconstructed right ankle. The operation, which took two hours, was performed Friday morning at Staten Island University Hospital in New York by Dr. Frank Ariosta, the director of orthopedics and the Center for Joint Reconstruction. According to Dr. Ariosta, "we were able to remove all of the hardware. She will stay in the hospital for a couple of days, then go home to recuperate. She should be on crutches for about two weeks. Once the wound is healed, we will start her on physiotherapy. She should be able to return to riding sometime in January."

LOCHSONG RETIRED

Lochsong (Song {GB}), voted Britain's Horse of the Year in 1993, has almost certainly run her final race. The six-year-old, a disappointing last in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, is apparently set for the breeding shed and a mating with Bluebird. Jeff Smith, her owner/breeder, said: "She did not run any sort of race in America and I'm not sure we'll ever know exactly why. She just wasn't herself. We were concerned for her, and having her back home now makes me want to call it a day. I would say it's 90 percent certain that is it for her. The other 10 percent is merely because we haven't thought things through. It will be very sad if it does end like this, but she's been champion sprinter in Europe for the past two years, and that takes some doing."

A four-length maiden winner in his first start at Aqueduct just eight days ago, Devious Course stretched out to a mile and kept his record at the Big A unblemished, rallying from near the back of the pack to take the lead at the top of the lane, then drawing clear in the drive to win his stakes debut with jockey Frank Alvarado aboard. "This is a nice colt," said trainer H. James Bond. "He sat off the pace and then just came and got it. Now we'll go to Florida, to Payson Park, to rest up and wait for Gulfstream to open." The 6-5 favorite **THUNDER GULCH** (Gulch), runner-up in the Cowdin, ran evenly under jockey Jerry bailey to finish fourth.

KEENELAND CONTINUES R. S. Evans paid a top price of \$120,000 for the four-year-old Act (Mr. Prospector) during Friday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Taylor Made Sales Agency sold the broodmare, in foal to Private Terms. A total of 289 horses went through the ring Friday for a gross of \$5,871,500, up 77 percent over the sixth-session gross in '93; the average of \$20,317 was up 79 percent over the same session last year.

BREEDERS' CUP SETS HANDLE RECORD

Total simulcast and off-track wagering on the seven Breeders' Cup Championship races last Saturday established a new North American record of \$68,078,015, a one percent increase over last year. Wagering on the '94 Breeders' Cup was offered at 745 simulcast and off-track locations across the United States and Canada. At Churchill Downs, a Breeders' Cup record crowd of 71,671 bet \$9,572,887. The grand total for all Breeders' Cup wagering, on-track and simulcast, was \$77,650,902.

FRENCH GUINEAS SET FOR ONE CARD IN '95

France's first two scheduled classics, the Dubai Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Pouliches (2000 and 1000 Guineas), will be run on the same day next year. The two races are scheduled for May 14 at Longchamp; the GI Prix Lupin, a prep for Europe's Derby events, will also be run that day. Other changes to France's racing programme, still in the process of adjusting to the pending demise of Maisons-Laffitte, include moving the GI Prix Jean Prat to June 4, Prix du Jockey Club Day.
