KEENELAND MAINTAINS MOMENTUM The figures for the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, which runs through Tuesday, continue to show major increases over last year. After seven days, the sale has grossed \$114,871,500 for 1,841 head; the '93 auction ran just seven days, selling 2,081 horses for \$91,394,400. The gross is already up nearly 26 percent with three days of the sale remaining. The average to date is \$62,396, a jump of 42 percent over '93. A weanling by Pine Bluff and a broodmare in foal to El Prado topped the seventh session with bids of \$72,000 each. David Fiske, agent, purchased the four-year-old mare All Ability (Nasty and Bold), who was consigned by Michael Byrne, agent. Phil Owens was the buyer of the weanling filly; consigned by Rolling Hills Farm, she is out of SW Cup of Honey and a 1/2 to Canadian champion Truth Of It All. Two hundred and eighty-five hips went through the ring Saturday, bringing in \$4,255,600 for an average of \$14,932. Last year's seventh session grossed \$3,315,600 for 292 head, an average of \$11,354. Those figures represent increases of 28 and 31 percent, respectively.

POST PARADES DISCONTINUED FOR GI SPRINTS IN BRITAIN Post parades for Group One sprint races, the cause of controversy in Britain all year, have been abolished. The axe has fallen on these once mandatory events following public outcry concerning incidents which involved the champion sprint mare Lochsong. On two occasions in '94, before the July Cup and the Nunthorpe S., Lochsong apparently lost all chance when she became upset during the lengthy pre-race parades. Paul Greeves, adviser to the British Horse Racing Board, admitted, "Lochsong is the immediate cause of the review," adding, "The original decision to have parades for sprint races was pretty marginal, and no one was surprised when they became an issue. Now both the BHB and the Jockey Club take the view that they should be banned." Parades will continue to be compulsory in Group One races featuring three-year-olds and up for distances beyond seven furlongs.

Making her first start over the Aqueduct turf, the well-traveled Market Booster shipped in after a victory in the Dowager S. at Keeneland and made it two in a row, closing from the middle of the pack to take the lead a quarter-mile from home, and cruising to a decisive win under jockey Mike Luzzi. "We were content to let her relax; under the wire the first time I was tucked in about fourth in good position," said Luzzi. "Down the backstretch she found her run. The leaders seemed to get tired, so we kind of inherited the lead. She was so relaxed and so strong--she was much the best today." The favored coupling of Lady Affirmed and PETITENESS (Chief's Crown) both closed late to take the minor awards. ZAFFERA (Alleged) making her first start in the States after running in England and Italy, raced for purse money only because of discrepancies in her past performances; she finished 10th.
