**"LONESOME" GOES FOR THE GLORY IN COLONIAL CUP** Bidding for his third straight Eclipse Award as Champion Steeplechaser, **Lonesome Glory** (Transworld) hooked the pretender to his throne, **Mistico (Chi)** (Balconaje {Arg}) at the 17th and final fence and the two battled to the wire, with the champ prevailing by a head to take the \$100,000 Colonial Cup at Camden, South Carolina yesterday. Steeplechasing's top money earner, **Victorian Hill** (Dickens Hill {Ire}), was another 21 lengths back in third. Last year's winner of the Colonial Cup, **Declare Your Wish** (Lyphard's Wish {Fr}), pressed the pace but tired to be fourth, while English invader **Crystal Spirit** (Kris {GB}) showed brief foot but was eased in the drive. With regular rider Blythe Miller in the saddle, the six-year-old Lonesome Glory picked up his third win of the season, which could earn him the Eclipse once again. His competition in the voting will come from runner-up **Mistico**, winner of the Iroquois S. and the New York Turf Writers Cup earlier in the campaign, and **Warm Front** (Northern Baby), who captured the Breeders' Cup Grand National last time out but fell at the 15th fence Sunday. Kentucky-bred Lonesome Glory, who races for his breeder, Walter M. Jeffords, now has 12 wins and \$335,254 to his credit.

**AMERITOP TOPS KEENELAND'S SUNDAY SESSION** Fawn Leap Farm paid a top price of \$80,000 for the broodmare prospect **Ameritop** (Top-sider) at Sunday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. The three-year-old, consigned by Silverleaf Farms Inc., is a half-sister to stakes winners **American Chance** and **Ophidian**. A total of 241 horses sold yesterday for \$2,984,600, an average of \$12,384. The sale continues through Tuesday.

After breaking his maiden by just a neck but in an impressive time, **Afternoon Deelites** jumped right into stakes company and won convincingly, passing the frontrunners as they straightened into the stretch and pulled away to win it while lugging in late in the lane. "Since the day we got this horse, we knew he could run," said trainer **Richard Mandella**. "In the mornings, he's done everything we ask him to do and more. I'm not surprised he won, but the time was so fast and he beat (**Valid Wager**) so easy...that did surprise me, because the other colt has some class." **Mandella** added that the **Hollywood Futurity** would be next.
