\$5 MILLION RENOVATION PROJECT FOR TURFWAY PARK

Turfway Park has undertaken a \$5 million remodeling project; scheduled for completion in January, the renovations will create a brighter racetrack with new areas for handicapping as well as viewing both live races and simulcasts. The centerpiece of the project will be a new ground floor with the look of a Las Vegas race book. The 29,000 square-foot area will offer fans more seating and 258 handicapping stations in front of five 9x12 foot projection monitors and 68 large-screen televisions. A new heating and air-conditioning system has been installed on the ground floor, rest rooms have been added, and concession stands and their menus have been expanded. The facility's parking lots will be paved and lighting has been added to all lots. A new lighting system for the racetrack itself will enhance the fans' view of the races; a "dimmer" will allow the lighting level to be lowered between races and dramatically brought up at post time. A new clubhouse entrance plaza will be completed in the spring.
