ASCOT FESTIVAL GETS WEEKEND SPOT

Ascot's Festival of Racing, which features several major English events such as the Queen Elizabeth II S. and the Fillies Mile, will become a two-day weekend fixture in 1995. Next year's meet, with added prize money in excess of 800,000 British pounds, will be run Saturday Sept. 23 and Sunday, Sept. 24.

CHRB TO CREATE SIMULCASTING GROUP

With simulcasting currently accounting for about 70 percent of California horse racing's \$2 billion annual parimutuel handle, the California Horse Racing Board moved Friday to protect the state's share of the market by spearheading the creation of an industry group with the responsibility of keeping California in front of competition from other states. "The idea is to create a simulcasting industry group that will include every sector of the industry," explained CHRB Commissioner James Watson, who chairs a subcommittee that is addressing simulcasting issues. "Some of the solutions may be legislative in nature. We may require a collective marketing strategy for the entire state. And certainly we need to explore technological advances. By working together, the group should be able to come up with recommendations to increase revenue to horsemen, the associations, and to the state." Watson indicated that Norm Towne, executive director of the Federation of California Racing Associations, and Al Karwacki, general manager of Southern California Off-Track Wagering, Inc., will be inviting other industry representatives to participate.

STUD Britain's 1993 St. Leger winner, **Bob's Return** (Bob Back), will be retired to Southcourt Stud in Bedfordshire, England. The four-year-old will remain in the ownership of Mrs. Jackie Smith; he will stand for a fee of 2,500 British pounds (\$4,000).

A winner for a \$50,000 tag two starts back, Franchise Player followed a fifth-place finish in the GIII Knickerbocker H. with a rallying victory as the weaker half of the second-choice 3-1 entry. Last after a half, the five-year-old Ohio-bred came flying down the lane to take the lead in midstretch and hold off the favorite Red Bishop in the photo. "The turf was soft and I couldn't ask him to run much on the turns; he wasn't able to handle the turns," said winning jockey Dale Beckner. "But he had a good run on the backstretch and a real nice run in the stretch."

Thoro-Graph Analysis of the Hollywood Derby by Jerry Brown

If you stop to think about it, you can count the horses in the last 20 years who were truly top quality on both dirt and turf on the fingers of one hand. Secretariat, Tentam and John Henry come to mind, but who else was truly Grade I quality on both surfaces?

What this means to the sophisticated handicapper is that the presence of a high profile dirt horse in a grass race makes for a good betting opportunity--on someone else. **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) continues his imitation of the Eveready Rabbit Sunday; after a tough campaign, just two weeks after the Breeders' Cup and a cross-country ship, he's still going...this time on grass. No thanks.

Very quietly this fall, a star has emerged in the west. **River Flyer** (Riverman) hasn't even competed in a stake this year, but the Thoro-Graph figures he earned in his two galloping allowance wins at Santa Anita would have put him on the wire with Baratheia in the Breeders' Cup Mile. The possible negatives are relatively short rest and possible bad racing luck in a huge field, but River Flyer has top figures, tactical speed and will be a square price. River Flyer to win.
