**HONG KONG A HIT IN CALIFORNIA** Results of Hollywood Park's first simulcast from Hong Kong produced a California handle of \$311,472, far exceeding expectations. Hollywood and Bay Meadows each imported the eight-race card from Sha Tin Racecourse Friday night; betting at Hollywood and its satellite sites came to \$215,785, with an additional \$95,687 wagered at Bay Meadows. The program began at 9:30 p.m. and concluded at 1:00 a.m. Saturday. "We saw people at the race track and in the Casino who were here for the first time because of the Hong Kong races," said Hollywood Park Chairman R. D. Hubbard. The on-track attendance of 10,472 at Hollywood was up more than 80 percent from a year ago, when racing was held in the afternoon. The combined handle was up 35.3 percent from '93. There will be four more cards imported from Hong Kong this year: Saturday, Nov. 26; Friday, Dec. 2; Saturday, Dec. 10; and Friday, Dec. 16.

### HOLY BULL T-SHIRTS TO BENEFIT

**CHARITY** Holy Bull (Great Above), soon to be named 1994's Horse of the Year, will make an appearance at Calder Race Course Saturday, December 10, to kick off a national T-shirt campaign to benefit local and national charities. The charities, chosen by Holy Bull's owner/trainer Jimmy Croll, will include the Grayson Research Foundation and the North American Handicapped Riding Association; they will divide the proceeds from the sale of a limited edition Holy Bull T-shirt designed by award-winning cartoonist Peb. The shirts will go on sale for the first time at Calder, with all proceeds from Calder sales going to the St. Francis Chapel Spiritual Rehabilitation Center in Ft. Lauderdale. After December 10, the T-shirts, which sell for \$15, will be available at participating tracks around the nation. The TRA will facilitate national orders and sales.

River Flyer was shooting for his first stakes win after three straight allowance victories on the grass; his last two, won by a combined 15 1/2 lengths, were at the Hollywood Derby distance. Hung wide on the first turn, the homebred colt made his way to the lead on the backstretch, was five in front at the top of the stretch, and cruised home to win it ridden out. "This horse is for real," said winning jockey Chris Antley. "He got off slow and still overcame it. My horse was running comfortably the whole way. I never even hit him. Believe me, this one is genuine." Trainer David Hofmans said the Hollywood Turf Cup December 11 could be next for the winner. Dare And Go, second in the GI Secretariat S. in his NA debut, had to settle for the runner-up spot again. The French import was shuffled back to next-to-last on the clubhouse turn but finished full of run to best longshot Fadayevev, another French-based colt making his U.S. bow, for the place. The 2-1 favorite TABASCO CAT (Storm Cat) chased the pace to the stretch, but faded in the drive to finish eighth. "I think he handled the grass alright," said his rider, Pat Day. "He just didn't finish up the way we anticipated. I wouldn't want to discount his ability on the grass after this one effort. I think it might be a combination of things. It's been a long season for him." The Preakness and Belmont victor will take a break, possibly returning in the Gil San Fernando S. January 14.
