## HORSEMEN'S BLOODSTOCK SERVICES

**SALE RESULTS** The 1994 Horsemen's Bloodstock Services Breeding Stock and Horses of All Ages Sale, held Sunday at the Timonium Sales Pavilion in Maryland, grossed a total of \$324,700 for the 83 horses which went through the ring. The average of \$3,912.50 was up seven percent from last year's auction, when 109 horses sold for \$398,300, an average of \$3,654. The sales topper was the three-year-old filly Eye Catching; consigned by Taylor's Purchase Farm as agent, the daughter of Alydar--A Pretty Smile (Honest Pleasure) was sold for \$105,000 as a racing or broodmare prospect to Rutledge Farm.

## FRENCH INTRODUCE SEX ALLOWANCES

For many years, distaff performers racing in France have been obliged to compete on level terms with their male counterparts in the majority of two-year-old events run before August. But, as of next season, France will come into line with the rest of the world by introducing a three-pound allowance for early-season juvenile races. The news comes one year too late for **Tereshkova** (Mr. Prospector). Owned by Sheikh Mohammed, the two-year-old filly was beaten a head by the colt Expelled at level weights in the GIII Prix du Bois at Longchamp in June, and by a neck to General Monash, receiving two pounds in the GII Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte in July.

## SAM HOUSTON EXPANDS WEEKEND CARDS

Sam Houston Race Park announced Sunday that, beginning the week of November 28, live racing will be expanded on Fridays and Saturdays and eliminated on Wednesdays. In the revised schedule, the park will add two live races on Saturdays and one on Fridays. "We have also reduced the time between races; we think the combination of this faster pace and the four-day schedule will appeal to our growing fan base," said President James D. Noteware.

**CALLER I.D. TO PIN OAK STUD** Josephine Abercrombie of Pin Oak Stud has purchased a majority interest in GSW **Caller I.D.** (Phone Trick) from Hart Farm and Triumviri Stable. The stallion, now property of Pin Oak and Dr. & Mrs. E. C. Hart, will stand the '95 season at Pin Oak in Versailles, Kentucky for a fee of \$6,000, live foal.

**GI \$400,000 Matriarch S., 3yo/up, f/m, 9fT**

The probable field for the GI event is; **Alywow** (Alysheba), **Aube Indienne** (Bluebird), **Corrazona** (El Gran Senor), **Empress Club (Arg)** (Farnesio {Arg}), **Eternal Reve** (Diesis {GB}), **Exchange** (Explodent), **Fondly Remembered** (Skywalker), **La Frontera** (Green Dancer), **Las Meninas (Ire)** (Glenstal), **Pharma** (Theatrical {Ire}), **Skimble** (Lyphard), **Wandesta (GB)** (Nashwan), and **Zoonaqu** (Silver Hawk). Supplemental nomination **Fondly Remembered**, runner-up in the GI Yellow Ribbon S. last time out, worked five furlongs on the turf Sunday, going the distance in 1:01, handily. Trainer Richard Mandella said over the weekend that his turf filly **Corrazona**, winner of the GI Beverly Hills H. in July, will run in either the **Matriarch** or the **Dahlia H.** at a mile and a sixteenth December 24. Two **Matriarch** hopefuls worked at Hollywood Saturday; **MGSW Skimble**, who was third in this race last year, went seven furlongs in 1:26 4/5, while **GISW Zoonaqu**, third in the **Yellow Ribbon**, breezed five-eighths in 1:00 2/5. The winner of the **Yellow Ribbon**, **Aube Indienne**, is scheduled to have her final workout for the race tomorrow. Three-year-old **Las Meninas**, who captured the **English 1,000 Guineas** this year, makes her U. S. debut.
