REDDING, SEKITEI RYU O OUT OF JAPAN

CUP Redding (NZ) (Nassipour), one of two Australian horses pointing to Sunday's Japan Cup, has sustained an injury that threatens to end his racing career. After his first serious work over a mile on the Tokyo track yesterday, the five-year-old was found to have a swelling on his right front leg. X-rays later revealed that Redding had suffered a fracture to one bone and chips on another. Redding's connections have withdrawn from the race. In addition, Japanese runner **Sekitei Ryu O (JPN)** (Tosho Boy {JPN}) has been withdrawn due to lameness in his left front leg. Six-year-old **Fujiyama Kenzan (JPN)** (Lucky Cast), winner of seven races and approximately \$2.9 million, will run in his place.

SOVIET PROBLEM PREPARES FOR JAPAN

Soviet Problem (Moscow Ballet), preparing for her scheduled start in the \$1.9 million Sprinters Stakes in Japan Dec. 18, worked clockwise for the first time in her career Wed. and drilled five furlongs in :59 4/5 over the Bay Meadows turf course. "I think she worked faster than any other horse did the wrong way this morning," joked trainer Greg Gilchrist. "I think :59 4/5 is a pretty fair work. She seemed to negotiate going the wrong way fine. We'll work her again next Thurs. or Fri., and in the meantime we'll do some gate training with no handlers. They don't use handlers over there so we have to get her ready for that." The Japan Racing Association also does not allow the use of medication. Soviet Problem, a regular Lasix user, worked without it yesterday and didn't bleed, according to Gilchrist. The four-year-old filly, whose second-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Nov. 5 raised her career earnings to \$842,243, has raced with Lasix in her last 15 starts.

IRISH APPROACH MISSES OUT ON BONUS

Irish Approach (Irish River {FR}) missed his chance of securing a \$1 million bonus when finishing second in yesterday's Bateman Catering Hurdle at Cheltenham. The five-year-old gelding, trained for George Strawbridge by Jonathan Sheppard, needed to win the £10,000 event, plus another race at the British track next month, to win the rich prize for "The Sport of Kings Challenge." But the U.S.-based contender finished 1 1/4-lengths behind favorite **Relkeel**.

GI Yellow Ribbon heroine **Aube Indienne** (FR) (Bluebird) worked four furlongs on the turf in :49 yesterday with Matriarch rider Kent Desormeaux up. **La Frontera** (Green Dancer) also went a half-mile on the turf in :49, but trainer Charlie Whittingham said the three-year-old filly still isn't definite for the race. **Corrazona** (El Gran Senor), winner of the GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood earlier this year, breezed five furlongs on the main track Wed. in 1:01 1/5. **Las Meninas** (IRE) (Glenstal) blew out three furlongs on the turf in :35 1/5. Gary Stevens, who will be aboard for her North American debut, was in the irons. **Pharma** (Theatrical {IRE}) has been declared out of the race by trainer Alex Hassinger Jr. and is scheduled to be sent to

owner Allen E. Paulson's farm in Bonsall, Ca. "She didn't run very well in the Queen Elizabeth (Oct. 29 at Keeneland) and we've decided to give her some time off," said Hassinger. "But she will definitely be back at Santa Anita this winter." **Exchange** (Explodent), who sizzled five furlongs on the main track in :58 4/5 Monday, has trainer Bill Spawr puzzled. The six-year-old mare is infamous for her slow works. "I don't know what's going on," he said. "She's never worked like that in her life. It scares me." **Empress Club** (ARG) (Farnesio {ARG}) galloped a mile Wednesday. Trainer Charles Pinnell said a decision regarding whether or not to enter the South African champion will be made Thursday. Also probable for the Matriarch are **Skimble** (Lyphard), Nakatani; **Zoonacqua** (Silver Hawk), McCarron; **Fondly Remembered** (Skywalker), Delahoussaye; and **Wandesta** (GB) (Nashwan), Day.
