**CONCERN HONORED AT LAUREL** Robert E. Meyerhoff's **Concern** (Broad Brush), the Maryland-bred winner of the Breeders' Cup Classic, will be honored with a special tribute today at Laurel Park. The first 5,000 patrons with paid admissions will receive free, full-color posters of the three-year-old colt. Suitable for framing, the poster features Concern defeating **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) in the GI Classic. In addition, Meyerhoff and trainer Richard Small will be featured in a winners' circle ceremony. The top North American money-earner of 1994 with \$2,541,670 in his bankroll, Concern was recently sent to Pacoma Farm in Camden, South Carolina for a brief freshening. Small has indicated that the late-striding colt will probably return to the races early next year at Santa Anita.

**APPRENTICE INJURED IN SPILL AT AQUEDUCT** Aqueduct-based apprentice jockey Dale Beckner, who fell from his mount--Young and Regal--during yesterday's third race at the New York track, suffered a fractured right collarbone in the spill. According to Dr. Andy Samma, Chairman of Emergency Medicine at North Shore University Hospital, Beckner also is "experiencing a tingle in his left foot and will remain under observation for the next few hours. He may be admitted or he might go home later tonight."

**DR. ADAGIO TO HART FARM** Hart Farm in Morriston, Florida has acquired an interest in the stakes-winning and track-record-setting **Dr. Adagio** (Cure The Blues). As a two-year-old, the 16.2 hand chestnut, out of Champion Two-Year-Old filly Istria (GB), ran the fastest two-year-old time of the 1990 Keeneland fall meet and won Hawthorne's Don Leon S. by 10 1/2-lengths. Dr. Adagio will stand the 1995 season for a fee of \$2,500 live foal as the property of Hindmarsh Farm and Hart Farm.

## Thoro-Graph Analysis of the NYRA Mile

When you're handicapping an older horse stake in late November, the issue generally is that some of the contenders are "over the top," feeling the effects of a year-long campaign. **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag) is certainly a question mark in this area, especially in light of the stinker he threw at Churchill Downs.

At about this time last year, **Itaka** (Jade Hunter) got good at Aqueduct. Sent to Florida for the winter, he responded badly, running horribly at Gulfstream. Laying off for four months, Itaka's campaign began in late June. For him, this is the heart of his season and he is in mid-season form. At the weights, three of his last four figures will win this, and with a month since his last start, there's a good chance he won't bounce. Itaka to win. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many industry professionals to evaluate the ability of racehorses. The Canadian colt, winner of six of his eight career races, reeled off five in a row at Hastings Park before shipping to California; he tired to be sixth in the GII Del Mar Futurity, but bounced back to go wire-to-wire in the six-and-a-half furlong Drouillys Boy S. at Santa Anita. The gelding tries two turns for the first time. **Peaks And Valleys** (Mt. Livermore), another Canadian invader, is unbeaten in three tries. The Kentucky-bred captured the mile-and-a-sixteenth Cradle S. at River Downs and a pair of races at Woodbine. **Jambalaya Jazz** (Dixieland Band) tries stakes company after taking two sprints in a row at Keeneland.
