TURFWAY OPENS TODAY Turfway Park, in the midst of a \$5 million improvement program, launches its 25-day Holiday Meet this afternoon. The opening day feature, the Holiday Inaugural S., kicks off the \$300,000 stakes schedule for the meeting, which runs through December 31. Post time will be 7:00 p.m. Wednesdays through Fridays, and 1:30 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays, with Mondays and Tuesdays dark. The track will be closed Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, reopening for an eight-day stretch December 26; post time for the eight post-Christmas cards will be 1:30 p.m. The Turfway Winter-Spring Meet begins New Year's Day.

CALDER STAKES RENAMED FOR KENNY NOE Tropical at Calder President C. Kenneth Dunn announced Saturday the renaming of the \$100,000 Sunny Isle H. as the Kenny Noe, Jr. H. to honor the former Calder president and executive vice president, who was recently named president of the New York Racing Association. "It almost goes without saying that Kenny was the driving force in the ascension of Calder Race Course into a major racetrack," said Dunn. "He provided credibility for the racing program, created one of the best backstretches in the country and was instrumental in advancing the state's breeding program, particularly through the creation of the Florida Stallion Stakes. Any future success we may have will emanate from the foundation Kenny built here at Calder." Noe will be in Florida to attend to inaugural running of the Kenny Noe, Jr. H., set for December 24.

Cigar, who had campaigned almost exclusively on the grass, returned to the main track last time out and went wire-to-wire to win an Aqueduct allowance going a mile by eight lengths; the four-year-old came into the NYRA Mile with a record of two wins from just three dirt starts. Ridden by jockey Jerry Bailey, the Paulson homebred rated in fourth to the quarter pole, then took control of the race, galloping away from the field and winning as much the best. "Cigar really smoked them," said Bailey. "I rode him before, but that was on the grass and he was flat that day. On the dirt, he has been a different horse." Winning trainer Bill Mott was in Japan, saddling Fraise and Paradise Creek for the Japan Cup. The 2-1 favorite Devil His Due, giving 15 pounds to the winner, rallied from mid-pack but had to settle for the runner-up spot.

With a sweeping come-from-behind drive, Thunder Gulch rallied to nip Western Echo by a neck at the wire for his first graded stakes victory. After breaking his maiden at Belmont Oct. 4, the colt jumped up to graded stakes competition, picking up checks in the GII Cowdin and the GIII Nashua in his last two starts. "My horse was in a good spot throughout the race," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "Coming down the stretch he started to lug in quite a bit, so I couldn't let him run as much as I wanted to. I thought he could have won by a lot farther than he did--the last 80 yards I was just trying to keep him straight."
