JAPAN CUP GOES TO HOME TEAM The Japanese-based **Marvelous Crown** (Miswaki) outbattled **Paradise Creek** (Irish River {Fr}) in the stretch run of yesterday's Japan Cup to win the world's richest race by a nose over his American rival. In the process, the four-year-old gave Japan its third straight victory in the race, which is worth about \$4.03 million, and earned about \$1.74 million. It was another 1 1/4 lengths back to third-place finisher **Royce and Royce** (Tony Bin), also Japanese based. France's **Hernando** (Niniski) was fourth, ahead of the U.S. entrant **Sandpit** (Baynoun {Ire}), who led as the field turned for home but was squeezed between Royce and Royce and Paradise Creek in the stretch. Due to the incident, Pat Day, aboard Paradise Creek, was fined \$309 and Royce and Royce's rider, Norihiro Yokoyama, was fined \$103. **Grand Flotilla** (Caro {Ire}), a seven-year-old half-brother to the winner, finished eighth. **Marvelous Crown** sat behind the leaders to the stretch, then rallied past **Sandpit** and **Johann Quatz** (Sadler's Wells) (12th), but still had to run down Paradise Creek. "I was not sure if I had won until I saw the toteboard," said winning rider Katsumi Minai. A two-time stakes winner in Japan, **Marvelous Crown** is out of **Maurita** (NZ) (Harbor Prince), a GISW in New Zealand. The final time for the 1 1/2 miles was 2:23.60 and the crowd at Tokyo Race Course was 165,930.

CHURCHILL DOWNS FALL MEET POSTS RECORD NUMBERS The 1994 Fall Meet at Churchill Downs, which ended Saturday, was the most successful in the track's 105 years of autumn racing. Total wagering on Churchill races, including on-track, Kentucky ITW/OTB and out-of-state, was up 55 percent over 1993; the handle was buoyed by an impressive 438 percent increase in inter-state simulcasting and the track's third hosting of the Breeders' Cup. On-track handle, up 17 percent, and on-track attendance, which rose seven percent, were also strong for the meet. A record \$314,397 per day in overnight purses was paid out during the meet, placing Churchill behind only NYRA and Southern California in purse distribution. "Our goal is to be the number one racing center in North America," said Churchill Downs President and CEO Thomas H. Meeker.

Bouncing back from a seventh-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, Exchange returned to the turf for the first time since finishing off the board in the GI Gamely H. in May, '93. Made the second choice in the eight-horse field, racing's newest millionaire moved to the lead soon after the break, going head-and-head with ZONAAQUA (Silver Hawk) to the top of the lane, then digging down deep to best Aube Indienne at the wire. "Maybe she isn't a champion, but she's right next to 'em," said winning trainer Bill Spawr, who claimed the mare from her second career start for \$50,000. "This is my biggest win, and my most satisfying." Said jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., "She hopped leaving the gate...I was a little worried because I thought I was going to make an easy lead. I had to rush her a little to make the lead; then she was able to relax. I just tried to save her for the last part. (Aube Indienne) headed me, but my mare responded. She wanted to win this race." Favored ALYWOW (Alysheba) raced closer to the pace than usual but had no response in the drive, finishing seventh.

BREEDER JOHN SIKURA KILLED IN CAR

FIRE A brief police statement issued Sunday confirmed that John Sikura, 60, owner of Hill 'n' Dale Farms and involved in horse racing for 35 years, died accidentally in a car fire at his 50-acre property north of Toronto Friday evening. Sikura was alone in his car when it apparently exploded. Police treated it as a "suspicious" death at first, but foul play has now been ruled out. Sikura, who also owned a farm in Lexington, bred Canadian champion Driving Home, winner of the 1980 Queen's Plate, and GSW Rahy. Born in Czechoslovakia, Sikura arrived in Canada with his family at 16, working as a laborer, an automobile salesman and a real estate salesman before starting his own real estate business. He leaves five children.

TATTERSALLS DECEMBER YEARLING SALE

SHOWS GAINS Both the average and the gross showed major increases at the Tattersalls December Yearling Sales, held last Tuesday and Wednesday. A total of 177 yearlings were sold during the two-day auction, bringing in 1,937,150 guineas; that figure was up 10 percent over '93 when 201 hips sold for 1,764,200 guineas. The '94 average, 10,944 guineas, posted a gain of 25 percent over the average of 8,777 guineas in '93. The sales topper was a bay filly by Sadler's Wells--Ridge The Times, by Riva Ridge; consigned as property of Islanmore Stud, Ireland, the 1/2 to top Irish two-year-old Pharaoh's Delight, winner of this year's GI Heinz "57" Phoenix S., attracted a bid of 125,000 guineas from G. Gordon-Watson Bloodstock.

TATTERSALLS DECEMBER FOALS SALE

RESULTS A total of 539 weanlings were sold during the three sessions of the 1994 Tattersalls December Foals Sales which ended Saturday. The gross for the sale was 7,118,110 guineas, down fractionally from last year when 512 lots went for 7,155,970 guineas. The '94 average of 13,206 guineas was down five percent from the average of 13,977 guineas a year ago. A weanling colt by Sadler's Wells--Amorique (Ire), by Top Ville (Ire) brought the highest bid at the sale; consigned by West Blagdon, the bay, first foal of a daughter of Irish 1000 Guineas winner Arctique Royale, was sold for 160,000 guineas to German International Bloodstock. "The rise in average at the December Yearling Sale has been followed by a good foal trade," said Tattersalls Sale Chairman Edmond Mahony. "Happily we have had a strong and competitive demand for foals throughout the three days, contrary to some of the pre-sale forecasts."

EVERETT NOVACK NAMED OCTOBER

"OWNER OF THE MONTH" The "Owner of the Month" award, sponsored by Gainsborough Farm, honors Everett Novack for October. Novack's New Farm had 13 starters at the Meadowlands during the month, posting six wins, two seconds and two thirds with earnings of just under \$400,000; his Conveyor was the longshot winner of the GI Meadowlands Cup October 14. In addition, New Farm's Meritocrat captured the GII Boojum H. at Belmont October 9 for his fifth consecutive victory. Raised in Cherry Hill, New Jersey, Novack worked at Garden State Race Track while in high school. He purchased New Farm in Marlton, New Jersey in 1987. Novack and his wife of 37 years, Nancy, who is active in the daily operations of New Farm, currently have 31 horses in training with Ben Perkins Sr., and 10 yearlings.
