**CRIST HIRED BY NYRA** Steven Crist, former New York Times racing writer and editor-in-chief of the Racing Times, will be appointed to a key New York Racing Association executive position overseeing several departments, the *New York Daily News* reported in yesterday's edition. Crist will fill some of the holes left after several NYRA executives, including Vice President/Marketing Allen Gutterman, were let go earlier in the week. Crist's appointment will be made official at a press conference Monday, at which time his exact duties will be spelled out. Crist left the New York Times to launch the Racing Times, which folded February 7, 1992. In the interim, he served on the Governor's Advisory Commission on Racing In The 21st Century and wrote on a freelance basis.

**NORTH-AMERICAN HORSES INVITED TO HONG KONG** Four North American-based horses have been invited to participate in Hong Kong's international racing festival, slated for December 11. **River Majesty** (Majestic Light) and **Sir Mark Sykes** (IRE) (Reference Point {GB}) have been selected to compete in the 1 1/8-mile Hong Kong International Cup, while **Megan's Interco** (Interco) and **Nijinsky's Gold** (Lot o' Gold) have received invitations to the seven-furlong Hong Kong International Bowl. Both races will be run over Sha Tin Racecourse's turf course.

**GOFFS SALES RESULTS** Goffs Bloodstock Ltd. held its November Premier Foal & Breeding Stock Sale November 18-20 at the Kildare Paddocks in Ireland. The sales topper was the 10-year-old bay mare **Darara** (Top Ville), a Group 1 winner in France and the joint second Top Rated Three-Year-Old Filly in Europe in 1986. The dam of multiple stakes-winner Dariyoun (Shahrastani), Darara, a half-sister to champion Darshaan (Shirley Heights), is in foal to Shirley Heights. Consigned by Sheshoon Stud, agent for H.H. Aga Khan's Studs S.C., the mare was purchased for 470,000 guineas by Charles Gordon-Watson. A total of 565 horses brought 5,335,650 guineas for an average of 9,444 guineas, up two percent from the 1993 average of 9,264. The sale's median of 5,400 represented a decrease of 10 percent from last year, when the median was 6,000.

Trainer Allen Jerkens will saddle the Harbor View Farm-owned entry of three-year-olds **Caress** (Storm Cat) and **Petiteness** (Chief's Crown). Randy Schulhofer, assistant to trainer Scotty Schulhofer, said Tuesday morning that his father will also have a pair in the race--Anstu Stable's **Irving's Girl** (Badger Land) and Julian Cohen's **Symphony Lady** (Theatrical {IRE}). "Both of them are hard-hitting, consistent fillies," said the younger Schulhofer. "Jose Santos will be in to ride Irving's Girl and Heberto Castillo will ride Symphony Lady." Canadian-bred Irving's Girl, a close second last out in the Gill Athenia H. at Aqueduct, defeated GI winner Dahlia's Dreamer in an allowance at Belmont in early September. Other My Charmer prospects expected to make their Florida season debuts Saturday: **Cox Orange** (Tremolino), **Putthepowderoit** (Talc), **La Turka** (Turkoman), **Flower Circle** (Lieutenant's Lark), **So True** (Lord At War {ARG}) and possibly **Gray Mood** (Relaunch). The Calder-based probables are **Liberada** (Spend a Buck), **Spectacular Image** (Spectacular Bid), **Good Morning Smile** (Morning Bob) and **Mia Bird Too** (Proud Birdie). Leslie Alexander's **Saxuality** (Dynaformer), trained by W.V. (Red) Terrill, was injured in a workout Monday morning at Calder and will not be entered.

**PORTRAIT GALLERY TOPS TATTERSALLS**

**FIRST SESSION** Portrait Gallery (IRE) (Sadler's Wells), a four-year-old gray colt, topped the bidding at 92,000 guineas during the first session of the Tattersalls Ltd. Mares, Horses in and out of Training and Stallions Sale at Newmarket Monday. Listed as a horse-in-training, the colt, a full-brother to Irish G1-winner El Prado (IRE), has won three races to date and placed six times, including a second-place finish in the G2 Blandford S. at The Curragh in Ireland.

Consigned to the sale by Ridge Manor Stables, Ireland, the colt was purchased by B.B.A. Italia. Overall, 172 horses were sold for a total of 3,409,191 guineas and an average of 19,820 guineas, down 8.7 percent from last year's first session average of 21,715 guineas. The sale continues through Dec. 2.
