DERBY WINNER FOOLISH PLEASURE DEAD

AT 22 Foolish Pleasure (What a Pleasure), the winner of the 1975 Kentucky Derby who had been standing stud at Ron Vanderhoef's Horseshoe Ranch in Wyoming, died November 17 of a ruptured stomach. The 22-year-old stallion, who was champion two-year-old and won 16 races and more than \$1.2 million, was discovered in his stall on the ranch showing signs of severe colic; despite surgery, which revealed the rupture, the stallion could not be saved. He was buried on the ranch in the pasture with his mares. Bold Forbes, 21, is now the oldest living Derby winner.

ROMERO BACK IN THE WINNER'S CIRCLE

Jockey Randy Romero, who announced his retirement from riding last July but returned to the saddle November 26, picked up the first win of his comeback in Thursday's third race at Hollywood Park. The 36-year-old Louisiana native piloted Sabreen to victory in the \$50,000 claiming event, paying \$29.40. "I guess you could say riding a winner is like riding a bicycle," said Romero. "You don't forget how to do it, and I've been doing it since I was eight years old."

PASEANA TO RACE AT EIGHT Champion **Paseana (Arg)** (Ahmad) will race again next year, trainer Ron McAnally confirmed Friday morning. The seven-year-old mare will take aim at the all-time distaff money title, currently held by the Japanese-based filly Hishi Amazon (Theatrical), who topped the \$4 million mark with her last victory.

UPWARD TREND CONTINUES AT

TATTERSALLS The fourth of five sessions of the Tattersalls Mares, Horses In and Out of Training and Stallions Sale, held Thursday, showed continued gains in both gross and average. A total of 147 lots were sold for 1,239,876 guineas, up 16 percent over the same session in '93 when 153 horses sold for 1,065,490 guineas. The '94 average of 8,434 guineas showed a 21 percent increase over last year's figure of 6,963 guineas. **Subtle Blush** (Nashwan), a three-year-old half-sister to GSW's Sarhoob and Sifting Gold, topped the session; consigned by Beckhampton House Stables, property of Dr. C. E. Stelling (part of a dispersal), the filly attracted a bid of 46,000 guineas from B.B.A. (UK) Ltd.
