TATTERSALLS WRAP-UP The 1994 Tattersalls December Sales concluded Friday with the fifth session of the Mares, Horses In and Out of Training and Stallion Sale. A total of 99 lots sold for 466,650 guineas, an average of 4,713 guineas. There was no comparable session last year. The high bid of 37,000 guineas came in for **Petite Memories** (Secreto); consigned by Loretta Lodge Stables, the three-year-old half-sister to stakes winner Crownette was purchased by Walnut Green Bloodstock. Overall, a total of 1,528 horses were sold for 26,505,565 guineas; the gross was up six percent over '93 when 1,429 lots sold for 25,072,513 guineas. The average showed a slight decline, down from 17,545 guineas in '93 to 17,346 guineas this year. "We have had a healthy week's trading," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "Competition for mares and fillies has been strong at all levels, and the year has ended on a very positive note."
