### DUCHOSSOIS EXPECTED TO REFUSE

**'95 DATES** Unless Illinois Racing Board Chairman Gary Starkman can make a deal Monday, Arlington International Racecourse owner Dick Duchossois is expected to announce Tuesday that he is turning down the May 12-October 8, 1995 dates he was awarded in September. The reason for the impending shutdown is the failure of the Illinois legislature to act on Duchossois' plea for a riverboat casino during its fall veto session that ended Thursday. Duchossois contends he will lose from \$6 million to \$10 million if he conducts the meeting as scheduled because of the competition from a new riverboat casino that opened in early October 12 miles away in Elgin. All 10 riverboat casino licenses permitted under the present Illinois statute have been awarded. Duchossois and others--most notably Chicago Mayor Richard Daley--are asking that the law be changed so that they can get in on the casino action; Duchossois wants to use a portion of the revenues from the casino he would construct to pump up purses at his track. Some of the legislators at the fall veto session were lame-duck Democrats. When the legislature reconvenes in January they will be out of office and Republicans will control both houses. Duchossois has been a major contributor to the GOP in the past and consensus is that the legislature then may be willing to give him some or all of what he wants for Arlington. But Duchossois has been insisting for months that he isn't going to wait for help if it means his track is going to take a major financial hit from the Elgin riverboat casino next year. "While Arlington is debt-free, I am no longer willing to continue the tremendous personal financial drain caused by a completely tilted playing field," he told the Racing Board when the 1995 dates were awarded. If Duchossois shuts down for the year, the Thoroughbred dates would be divided between Sportsman's Park and Hawthorne Race Course. It is also conceivable that Balmoral Park, now a harness track, could get back into the Thoroughbred picture. Because Sportsman's and Hawthorne also conduct harness racing, revising the Thoroughbred schedule would play havoc with the standardbred schedule. If Arlington does shut down next year, the track is expected to keep its inter-track facility open to take bets on races from the other Illinois tracks.

Showing his affinity for the Hollywood surface, multi-millionaire Best Pal sat at the back of the pack for three-quarters, then launched a bid that carried him from worst to first, circling the field and pulling away for his sixth win from seven starts over the track. "He really is a remarkable horse," said his owner/breeder John Mabee. "We've been a little disappointed with his season this year, but things happen that way. We're looking forward to his seven-year-old season." Trainer Richard Mandella indicated that the Santa Anita H. March 11 would be the gelding's main objective next year, with the San Pasqual January 22 and the San Antonio H. February 14 used as possible preps. Tossofthecoin closed ground late to be second while no match for the winner; pacesetter Royal Chariot held on to be third. Second choice SEA CADET (Bolger) was up with the pace early but faded in the stretch. "He ran hard and I was laying where I wanted to be," said his jockey, Alex Solis. "But another horse moved up outside of me and my horse just didn't want to go on. He didn't have any breathing problems. This just wasn't his day."
