'95 WOOLF AWARD TO EDDIE MAPLE

Eddie Maple, a successful member of the New York jockey colony for more than 20 years, has been selected to receive the 1995 George Woolf Memorial Jockey Award in voting by members of the Jockeys' Guild nationwide. The award was established at Santa Anita in 1950 to recognize riders for high standards both professionally and personally. Maple, who rode his first winner in 1966 at Ascot Park in Ohio, has piloted such champions as Secretariat, Foolish Pleasure, Devil's Bag, Swale, Dehere and Sky Beauty; he won two Belmont Stakes, aboard Temperance Hill (1980) and Creme Fraiche (1985). The Woolf Award will be presented during a ceremony at Santa Anita during the 1994-95 racing season.

FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC MIXED SALE RESULTS

The first session of the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed sale, held Sunday at the Timonium Sales Pavilion in Maryland, saw 193 horses sold for a total of \$853,600. The gross was down 20 percent from 1993, when 224 hips went for \$1,075,000. The '94 average, \$4,423, showed a decrease of eight percent from last year's average of \$4,799. The session topper was an unnamed two-year-old filly by Seeking the Gold--Veiled Look (Cyane); consigned as a broodmare prospect by Walnut Green (Jones Bros.), agent, the filly went for a bid of \$32,500 to Roger L. Toffolon.

JAPAN ONE-TWO IN WORLD SUPER

JOCKEY SERIES Japanese riders Takayuki Ishizaki, first, and Yutake Take, second, finished one-two in the 12-man World Super Jockeys Series, held in Japan this past weekend. American Jerry Bailey fared the best of the foreign visitors, finishing third. "This was my first experience of the championship and I was pleased with both the warm welcome and the result," said Bailey.

Sunday, Hollywood

GI \$500,000 Hollywood Turf Cup, 3yo/up, 12fT

The probable field for the Grace I event is: **Dare And Go** (Alydar), **Franchise Player** (Mr. Redoy), **Jackdidi** (Ti King {Fr}), **Lindon Lime** (Green Dancer), **Mashaallah** (*Nijinsky II), **Regency** (GB) (Dancing Brave), **River Flyer** (Riverman), **Savinio** (The Minstrel), **Southern Wish** (Lyphard's Wish {Fr}), **Square Cut** (Assert {Ire}) and **Truly A Dream** (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}). Lindon Lime has finished first or second in six of his nine NA starts, including victories in the Sam Houston H. at the Dueling Grounds and the River City H. at Churchill Downs. The four-year-old gelding was first alternate for the Breeders' Cup Turf but failed to draw in. "Hopefully we won't be in that position next year," said his trainer, Elliott Walden. "We felt he belonged in the race...he certainly belongs in the Hollywood Turf Cup. He absolutely loves a mile and a half; it's his best distance." Dare And Go worked seven furlongs on the main track at Hollywood Sunday, going in 1:28 1/5. The two Bobby Frankel runners worked on the turf: Regency went seven furlongs in 1:27 2/5, while stablemate Mashaallah went a mile in 1:46 2/5.

GIII \$75,000a Queens County H., 3yo/up, 8.5f

Trainer John Destefano will send out MGSW **Michelle Can Pass** (Pass Catcher). The Florida-bred is winless in nine starts this year, but he has been on the board five times. "He seems to be taking more time getting into form this year," said the conditioner. "In a month he'll be seven--maybe old age is catching up with him." New York-bred **Excellent Tipper** (Vice Regent) will also be in the gate Saturday. "He's doing very well right now and he's run with the best around," said his trainer, P.G. Johnson. "I think he'll give a good account of himself." The six-year-old was second, beaten a nose, in an overnight handicap at Aqueduct last time out.
