The proposal includes studying the feasibility of creating with other industry groups a national accident insurance package which would provide benefits comparable to workers' compensation on a nationwide basis. The TRA placed a 5:00 p.m. EST deadline of Friday, December 16, for a definitive response to its proposal. In the meantime, it has agreed to continue working with the Guild to clarify or refine any details of the proposal.

The field of nine is headed by highweight **Key Contender** (Fit to Fight), 117. A recent \$170,000 purchase from the Fasig-Tipton Horses of Racing Age sale at Belmont, the six-year-old is making his second start for new trainer Jose Martin; he was sixth in the GI NYRA Mile last time out. Said Martin. "It was ambitious of us to run in there...but he beat some good horses. We've been a fan of this horse. He's gutsy, a fighter, and we thought we could do real good in the winter with him. Maybe we can add a graded stakes win to his resume. He's coming into the race really good, and we expect a good race from him." The speedy **Contract Court** (Conquistador Cielo), making his first start over Aqueduct's winterized inner track, led the field by as many as six lengths before tiring to finish third in an overnight handicap in his latest effort. The gelding, two-for-two over wet tracks, looks for his first win since taking a nine-furlong Saratoga allowance August 3.

We'll try to beat him with exactas.

Marvin's Faith (Ire) (Sharp Victor) and **Western Trader** (Herat) are both late-developing three-year-olds who put in major efforts a couple of months ago, bounced, and are now cycling back into form. They also benefit from advantageous pace and weight scenarios.
