JOCKEY JAMES THORNTON DIES

Jockey James Thornton, who suffered massive head injuries in a spill at Charles Town Friday evening, died yesterday at Fairfax Hospital in Virginia. Thornton was 54; he is survived by his former wife Rosalyn, to whom he was engaged to be remarried, and five daughters. Thornton's death was the third racing-related fatality at Charles Town. Joe Snyder was killed in a riding accident in the late 50's and Charles Hinojosa died July 21, 1985 following a spill.

MEADOWLANDS ENDS RECORD-SETTING MEET

Capping a record-setting season, the 1994 Meadowlands Thoroughbred meet closed Saturday night with the total nightly average handle topping \$2.6 million, the highest in the 19-year history of the track. "This has been a success from start to finish," said Hal Handel, executive vice president and general manager of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "The racing was solid from top to bottom and the public supported it both on-track and at our simulcast outlets." Total handle for the meet, \$180,773,736, was up nearly 36 percent from last year. On-track handle increased two percent to \$79,906,386, while the average daily on-track attendance dipped slightly, down one percent at 7,896. Two track records were set during the '94 meeting, with Sweet Beast setting the six-furlong standard of 1:07 4/5 and Conveyor dashing a mile and seventy yards in 1:38 2/5. Leading jockey Joe Bravo broke Julie Krone's single-season mark of 132 wins, ending the meet with 142 victories, while Daniel Lopez led the trainers with 36 wins. Lopez and Bill Martucci led the owners with 19 winners apiece.

AFTERNOON DEELITES WORKS FOR HOLLYWOOD FUTURITY

Burt Bacharach's undefeated two-year-old **Afternoon Deelites** (Private Terms) worked a bullet seven furlongs in 1:23 1/5 yesterday, prepping for Sunday's GI Hollywood Futurity. Jockey Kent Desormeaux was aboard the West Virginia-bred, who broke off behind a stablemate but crossed the wire three lengths in front. "I didn't even ask him until the wire," said Desormeaux of the colt, who began his breeze at the three-quarter pole and went out the extra eighth past the finish line. "He didn't want to stop. He's something else."

Frenchpark (GB), fourth in the GII Carleton F. Burke H. at a mile and a quarter in his NA debut, was overlooked in the betting but not at the wire. Allowed to settle well behind the leaders early, the European import moved to the outside on the far turn and finished fastest of all to take the lead inside the eighth pole and pull away. It was the four-year-old's first victory since taking the GIII EBF Beresford S. at The Curragh in October, 1992. "He bled pretty badly in his first (U.S.) start," said trainer Terry Knight, "and we learned a little bit more about him in the next month that I had him. I felt that this horse was going to run the best race he was capable of running, that's how well he was training. Truthfully, I was very confident." The winner was purchased for \$200,000 by Joe Kowal, a former NHL player for the Buffalo Sabres, Saturday night. Frenchpark gives his trainer his first Grade I win. The 9-5 favorite Dare And Go closed ground in the stretch but was no match for the winner. "He was a bit rank with me for the first 5/8's of a mile," said jockey Gary Stevens. "It took me a long time to get him to settle."

A huge crowd at Sha-Tin saw State Taj lead almost throughout to post a big upset in Hong Kong's richest race. River Majesty, trained by Chris Clement, closed powerfully for second under Jose Santos but could not catch his Australian rival, who had stolen a clear lead two furlongs out. Emperor Jones, trained in England by John Gosden and sent off the even-money favorite, was perfectly positioned in fourth but came up empty when it counted, fading to finish fifth.

Red Bishop stalked pacesetter Urgent Request to the top of the stretch, then flashed a brilliant turn of foot to sprint clear a furlong from home in the inaugural running of the International Vase. Trained by John Hammond in France, Red Bishop has become a world traveler, having just missed by a nose in his last start at Aqueduct, the GII Red Smith H. He has now posted 21 in-the-money finishes from 25 lifetime starts. Urgent Request employed the same front-running tactics he used in Oct. at Woodbine that saw him take the Rothman's field much of the way, but held on much better this time for a well-earned second. Favorite River Verdon pulled hard early, laying a close third while wide, but faded badly turning for home and finished 13th, beating just one horse.

The four-year-old was close-up throughout, yet had to overcome traffic problems to record his fourth win in his last five starts. New York's Nijinsky's Gold, under Jose Santos, closed resolutely to edge Heart Lake for second. California's Megan's Interco, sent off a strong favorite, never got untracked and trailed the field through most of the running, ending up in seventh place.
