HOLY BULL BREEZES In his first workout since Sept., likely Horse of the Year **Holy Bull** (Great Above) breezed three furlongs yesterday morning at Gulfstream Park. According to owner/trainer Jimmy Croll, the colt went in :37. Croll said that Holy Bull will work approximately every four days leading up to his four-year-old debut, the Jan. 22 Olympic H. "He's really matured and is doing excellent," said Croll. "Right now, I see no reason why he can't be as good or better than ever." Still, Croll does not anticipate an effortless first outing. "I have a feeling that his first race back is not going to be easy," he said. "There are going to be three or four people who are going to take a big shot at us first time out. There are some tough sprinters around here, and that makes me wary because I'm on a rather close schedule trying to get him ready." Holy Bull's tentative post-Olympic schedule: the Feb. 11 Donn H., March 11 Santa Anita H., and possibly the April 22 Excelsior H. at Aqueduct.

TEAM LUKAS FILLY UPDATE **Serena's Song** (Rahy), winner of Saturday's GI Hollywood Starlet, came out of the race in good order and will now be pointed for her three-year-old debut in the GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita February 19. Her trainer, D. Wayne Lukas, also conditions division leader **Flinders** (Seeking the Gold), and he remarked on the progress of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner since her surgery to repair a fractured right front cannon and sesamoid. "She's doing very, very well. There has been no decision as to her race career, but they're pleasantly surprised at how well she's doing."

PAST CHAMPS PREP FOR RETURNS Last year's champion two-year-old filly **Phone Chatter** (Phone Trick), away since finishing last after running down in the GI Spinster S. October 16, breezed seven furlongs in 1:24 4/5 at Santa Anita Sunday. Jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., aboard for the bullet move, will also be in the saddle for the Eclipse Award winner's next engagement, the La Brea S. December 28. **Eliza** (Mt. Livermore), the champion two-year-old filly of 1992, will also return to competition on that card, running in the Market Basket S. at six-and-a-half furlongs on the grass. The four-year-old was fifth last time out in the Lady's Secret H. October 10; her last victory came in the GI Santa Anita Oaks in March, 1993.

Sent off the overwhelming favorite in his first try at two turns, Afternoon Deelites proved the added distance was no problem at all. Sitting comfortably off the early pace of the speedy A. J. Jett, the undefeated colt was sent up to take the lead on the far turn and put in his most impressive performance to date, easily drawing away from the field to win as he pleased. "It's a long road to May, but we're hoping to get there," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He's just an extremely gifted horse. He does everything we ask him, and in triple. He's shown us no signs of surrender." Owner Burt Bacharach added, "This is as good as it gets." Winning jockey Kent Desormeaux remarked, "It was effortless, period. I really don't know what else to say--he humbled me." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who saddled runner-up Thunder Gulch, and also handles Breeders' Cup Juvenile victor Timber Country, said of the developing three-year-old picture, "It will be an interesting spring. Between now and spring, there will be other ones who crop up, too. You (press) guys will be able to handicap to your hearts' content." **THE EXETER MAN** (Capote), fourth after pressing the pace, bled badly.
