Highlighting the stakes program will be the \$800,000 Strub Series for four-year-olds, culminating in the \$500,000 Strub S. February 5; the \$1 million Santa Anita H. March 11, expected to draw probable Horse of the Year Holy Bull as well as the first four from this year's Breeders' Cup Classic: Concern, Tabasco Cat, Dramatic Gold and Soul of the Matter; and the \$500,000 Santa Anita Derby April 8. In all, 57 stakes, including 12 Grade I's, will be run at the meet which concludes April 24.

**TURF PARADISE CANCELS FRIDAY** After riding in five of the 11 scheduled live races Friday, the jockeys at Turf Paradise in Arizona met with track management and called off the remainder of the card due to inclement weather, which was adversely affecting an already sloppy track. ## AQUEDUCT • ACTION

**ATTENTION HORSEMEN:** There will be a change in the eligibility rule effective January 1, 1995. Stalls will not be allotted nor entries accepted: (i) for a horse which has started for less than \$7,500 unless winning for \$7,500 or more since then; (ii) for a horse which has started for \$10,000 or less and since starting for \$10,000 or less has not finished 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any of the past 10 starts, inclusive; (iii) for a maiden which has not finished 2nd, 3rd or 4th in any of its past 10 starts, inclusive; or (iv) for a horse which has started for less than maiden \$16,000 until winning.

Barrera S. He tries a sprint for the first time since finishing fourth in allowance company in July. **Numerous** (Mr. Prospector) returns to the dirt after four starts on the grass. I can't fault the way he has performed, but it has been very frustrating." The four-year-old colt just missed in his most recent outing, finishing just a half-length behind Chimes Band in the Gill Fall Highweight H.

The field of 10 is headed by GISW **Conveyor** (Sharp-en Up {GB}), 119, who took the GI Meadowlands Cup at a mile and an eighth and also set a track record for a mile and seventy yards at the Jersey oval this fall. The Ben Perkins trainee will be asked to shoulder topweight as he tries to win at the marathon distance of the Gallant Fox for the first time. Owner/trainer Murray Garren will send out his duo of **Federal Funds** (Settlement Day), 114, and **Jacksonport** (Vigors), 110, who finished first and second, respectively, in the Gill Queens County H. last time they ran. The pair have combined for 45 starts in '94; Jacksonport was third in this race last year, and second in '92.
