### FIVE CALDER JOCKEYS INJURED OVER

**CHRISTMAS WEEKEND** Five jockeys were injured in three separate incidents at Calder Race Course over the holiday weekend. Jockeys Joe Bravo and Enrique Jurado went down in the fifth race Saturday after Bravo's horse, Twisted Appeal, clipped heels and Jurado's mount, War Hero, stumbled over the fallen horse and rider. Bravo, briefly knocked unconscious, was hospitalized overnight but was released Sunday with a sore back and slight memory loss. Jurado suffered a bruised shoulder and elbow and was treated and released Saturday night. More seriously injured was apprentice jockey E. C. Lopez; Lopez was thrown during Saturday's 11th race when his mount, Glitter Ky. Moon, clipped heels and stumbled on the backstretch. Jockey Dodie Duys, aboard Sapere Aude, was unable to avoid the fallen rider and also went down. According to Lopez' father, jockey Carlos Lopez Sr., the 23-year-old rider suffered a broken cheekbone and a broken bone in his neck; he is in serious but stable condition in the Intensive Care Unit at Florida's Hollywood Memorial Hospital. Duys sustained only bruises and was treated by the track physician. Jockey Abdiel Toribio was injured during Sunday's ninth race when his mount, L's Golden Knight, broke down in midstretch. Toribio, transported to Hollywood Memorial, suffered a broken left clavicle; L's Golden Knight fractured his right front cannon bone and had to be put down.

**SARDULA RETIRED** Trainer Brian Mayberry announced Monday that **Sardula** (Storm Cat) has been retired and will go to Kentucky to begin a new career as a broodmare; she is scheduled to be bred to Seeking the Gold. Winner of five stakes, including the GI Hollywood Starlet at two and the GI Kentucky Oaks this year, Sardula goes to the breeding shed with a record of six wins from 10 starts and \$882,460.

**JULIE KRONE ENGAGED** Jockey Julie Krone has announced her engagement to Matthew Muzikar, 25, a reporter from Albany, New York television station WTEN. The pair have been dating since this summer and became engaged Christmas Day in Saratoga. Muzikar, who is 6' 4", and Krone met while he worked as a security guard at the track.

Powis Castle, who last visited the winner's circle following the grassy Oceanside S. at Del Mar in July and hadn't won on the dirt since sprinting in the Turfway Park Prevue S. more than a year ago, rebounded from an 11th-place finish in the GI Hollywood Derby in his last effort. Allowed to settle at the back of the pack early, the three-year-old rallied steadily to join the pacesetter favorite Ferrara in the lane, outgaming that rival to prove best at the wire. "The whole plan last year was to try and stretch this horse out and get (owner Berry Gordy) to the Derby," said trainer Rodney Rash. "It might have been that he's been wanting to sprint all along." Rash added that his charge was unlikely to point for the Strub Series. "I don't think he wants to go very far...I think we'll keep this horse sprinting now," he said. Said jockey Chris Antley, rider of runner-up Ferrara, "He ran game. They were four-fifths off the track record, and that's held by Spectacular Bid. My horse tried to come back; I just couldn't overhaul (Powis Castle) the last part."

**Local News: Santa Anita**

Santa Anita's opening day produced a record total handle for a meet opener with \$16,100,575 wagered on the card. The figure, the fifth highest in the track's history, was up 18 percent from opening day, 1993, when the previous record of \$13,646,648 was set. The day was marred by a three-horse spill in the first race, however. Jockey Fernando Valenzuela suffered two compressed fractures of the vertebrae and is expected to miss six to eight weeks; Chris McCarron suffered bruised ribs; Paul Atkinson was not injured, but all three riders took off their remaining mounts. The seventh race produced a record low trifecta payoff for the track; topped by 6-5 favorite **Crissy Aya**, the triple paid \$30.
