TOP BROODMARE PROSPECTS AT FASIG-TIPTON JANUARY

Fasig-Tipton's 1996 Winter Mixed Sale will be held today with a pair of stellar broodmare prospects topping the offerings. **Golden Klair (GB)** (Damister), retired after finishing fifth in the Jan. 1 Run for the Roses H. at Santa Anita, will be consigned by Chance Farm (Mr. and Mrs. S. Brooke Royster), agent, for owners No Problem Stable and Sido Stable. The six-year-old, a winner of 10 of 35 starts in North America and England for earnings of \$478,897, won four stakes at ages three and four, including the GII A Gleam H., GII Hawthorne H. and GII Silver Belles H., all at Hollywood Park. Also scheduled to go through the auction ring is the top sprinter **Mixed Appeal** (Mighty Appealing). Consigned by Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services Inc. (John Stuart), agent for the Estate of Israel Cohen, the eight-year-old won 20 of 60 starts for earnings of \$619,104. Among her eight stakes victories was a tally in the 1994 GII Barbara Fritchie H. at Laurel. Overall, 255 horses have been catalogued for the one-day sale, which begins at 11 a.m. this morning at Fasig-Tipton's Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, Kentucky.

CELTIC SWING STILL DUBAI POSSIBLE The 1995 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) winner **Celtic Swing (GB)** (Damister) is still possible for the \$4-million Dubai World Cup in March, according to his owner Peter Savill. However, the four-year-old colt's immediate future now rests on veterinary examinations to be undertaken during the next 10 days. Savill said, "He seems very well in himself, but it has been a slow healing process. He's coming on nicely, but the vets will make the decision on whether or not he can go back into full training later this month. If he does, then the Dubai race is very much still on his schedule."

IDE BACK IN TRAINING MONDAY Ide (Forty Niner), one of the early favorites for the 1996 Kentucky Derby, will be back at the track Monday after enjoying a vacation since his win in the Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill November 25. The colt, a winner of five of his seven starts at two, will begin training for his three-year-old campaign in Ocala, Florida before shipping to trainer Pete Vestal's barn at Oaklawn. "He will be sent to me January 28," said Vestal. "I hope to run him three times at Oaklawn--the Southwest S. (March 2), Rebel (March 23), and the Arkansas Derby (April 13)." **News cont. p2**

The Vid came back from a disappointing 12th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile to win the GIII Tropical Turf H. by six lengths Nov. 25, and was 3-2 to remain undefeated on the Gulfstream turf in his third start over the course. The chestnut raced behind pacesetter PRIME RATE POWERS (Deputy Minister) early, took the lead into the stretch and drew off handily. Dove Hunt rallied three-wide to best the rest of the field. Winning trainer Marty Wolfson was confident going into the race. "When I saw him in the paddock, I knew there was no way that he would lose. He's got a certain look --a look in his eye. He gets very aggressive. He lets you know when he is ready." As for the future, Wolfson said, "As big and strong as he looks, he is not a robust horse and I have to be careful with his training. He has to be fresh when he runs. We'll go in the Ft. Lauderdale (March 16 at Gulfstream) and the Early Times (Turf Classic at Churchill)." The race unfolded much like jockey Herb McCauley guessed. "Once I decided to go to the front, it was easy. My horse just took the lead and was in command the rest of the trip," he said. "It is nice when it works out like it's planned."

TURFWAY CALLS OFF SUNDAY CARD Turfway Park has canceled its live racing program for Sunday because of a winter storm which could prevent horses shipping from Lexington and Louisville from making the trip. However, the Race Book and the track's second-floor simulcasting area will remain open Sunday for a schedule of full-card simulcast racing. "Anticipated heavy snow to the south of Turfway will prevent many trainers from shipping here for Sunday's races, so we decided it was in everyone's best interest to cancel the live racing program," said General Manager Greg Schmitz. Live racing resumes Wednesday evening.

PHILADELPHIA CANCELS SATURDAY Racing had to be called off at Philadelphia Park once again yesterday, but this time it was Mother Nature who would not cooperate. The track, which has been closed since December 28 due to disputes with the horsemen and union employees, was scheduled to reopen Saturday, but the day's live card was canceled because of unsafe track conditions.

PALACE MUSIC TO JAPAN According to a report in yesterday's *Daily Racing Form*, **Palace Music** (The Minstrel), the sire of irrefutable 1995 Horse of the Year Cigar, will ship from Australia to Japan to stand the 1996 Northern Hemisphere breeding season. The 15-year-old has stood Down Under at Segenhoe Stud since 1991; he is scheduled to join the Yushun Stallion Station for the season, where he will stand for a fee of 1.5 million yen, about \$14,500.

Silver Goblin (Silver Ghost), who suffered a hair-line fracture of the left front cannon bone in last year's Met Mile, is in training at Oaklawn and conditioner Kenny Smith said yesterday he hopes to have his millionaire ready for the Oaklawn H. The five-year-old, who was originally retired after the injury, went back to the track December 10. "The injury wasn't all that severe," explained Smith. "The problem was the location...the fracture was on the outside of the major bone, low but not into the joint. It was in a place where no screws could be inserted. We just had to sit and wait for it to heal on its own. I think we have gone through most of the problems. There is no calcium deposit, but there is a bit of scar tissue. There is a small knot over the injury, but it is getting smaller." The trainer added that he hopes to give the grey gelding one race towards the end of the meet before coming back in the GI Oaklawn H. April 6. Silver Goblin topped a million dollars in earnings when he finished second to Cigar in the race last year.
