MARE IN FOAL TO WOODMAN TOPS

KEENELAND JANUARY OPENER Miss Profile (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a six-year-old broodmare in foal to Woodman, brought a bid of \$350,000 to top Monday's first session of Keeneland's January Horses of All Ages Sale. Horse France bought the mare, who is a half-sister to champion and MGISW Kostroma and G1SW Grise Mine; she was consigned by Ashford Stud, agent. Keeneland sold 250 horses on opening day of the sale for \$5,837,700; the gross was down 17.1 percent from the '95 opener, when 240 head brought \$7,047,200. Monday's average of \$23,351 was down 20.4 percent from last year's first-day average of \$29,363.

DUBAI FIELD SELECTED A field of 14 horses and 53 reserves have been selected for the inaugural running of the \$4,000,000 Dubai World Cup at Nad Al Sheba racecourse Wednesday, March 27. The selections, made by an international panel of handicappers and racing secretaries who met in London Friday, Jan. 5, include four runners from the United Arab Emirates, three from the Americas, three from Europe and two each from Oceania and Asia. The 14 have won 28 Grade I or Group 1 races among them and include champions from the Northern and Southern Hemispheres. They are listed by region as follows. The Americas: **Cigar** (Palace Music), **L'Carriere** (Carr de Naskra), **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms); Asia: **Lively Mount** (Jpn) (Green Mount), **Taiki Blizzard** (Seattle Slew); Europe: **Freedom Cry** (GB) (Soviet Star), **Pennekamp** (Bering {GB}), **Pentire** (GB) (Be My Guest); Oceania: **Jeune** (GB) (Kalaglow {Ire}), **Mahogany** (Aus) (Last Tycoon {Ire}); United Arab Emirates: **Annus Mirabilis** (Fr) (Warning {GB}), **Cezanne** (GB) (Ajdal), **Halling** (Diesis {GB}), **Moonshell** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). "The sheer quality of the field for the inaugural Dubai World Cup exceeds even the ambitious expectations that we had when the Dubai World Cup was first conceived," said Michael Osborne, chairman of the Dubai World Cup Committee.

Saturday, Gulfstream Park

BROWARD H.-GILL, \$75,000, 3yo/up, 8.5f

Flying Chevron (Carson City), winner of the GI NYRA Mile in his latest effort and five-for-seven lifetime, worked five furlongs in 1:01 at Gulfstream yesterday morning and will make his seasonal bow in the Broward. "(The work) was exactly what we wanted," said trainer Jimmy Toner. "He did it comfortably and he came back good." Toner added that the four-year-old will be pointed to the Strub S. at Santa Anita, "mainly because Cigar won't be there." Also possible for the Broward is **Takeawakatlove** (Miswaki); the lightly raced five-year-old gelding has started just six times but has four wins to his credit. "He took a while to get ready to run, and since then he has had some minor ailments," said trainer Frank Brothers. "He has done everything we have asked him to do. I think he will run well fresh. He is sharp right now." The chestnut has not started since taking back-to-back allowance races in Kentucky last October. He makes his stakes debut.

HORSES SWITCHED AT SOUTHWELL Confusion reigned at Southwell racetrack in England yesterday when one of trainer Reg Hollinshead's horses ran in place of another by accident. Hollinshead's **Loch Style (GB)** (Lochnager {GB}) was due to run in the Kerry Selling Stakes, but instead was sent out in place of the stable's **Taniyar (Fr)** (Glenstar) in the Waterford Maiden Stakes earlier on the card. The error was only discovered prior to Taniyar's appearance in the selling race. "The two horses are similar types," said the embarrassed trainer. "Both are bay geldings. But we should not have made the mistake." The local stewards referred the matter to the Jockey Club, which will now hold an enquiry to see if Hollinshead was in breach of the Rules Of Racing. A Southwell racecourse official said, "It was all very unfortunate, but the buck has to stop with the trainer." Jockey Ray Cochrane was due to ride both of Hollinshead's horses. He is reported to have said after Loch Style had run in a race five furlongs further than his scheduled appearance, "He couldn't have got the distance in a horse box!"

RACING CANCELLATIONS MONDAY The "Blizzard of '96" caused the cancellation of racing at three East Coast tracks Monday; Laurel Park, Philadelphia Park and Suffolk Downs were all forced to call off their programs due to the storm.

OJAI TO STAND AT BONNIE HEATH Ojai (Strawberry Road {Aus}), a GSP full-brother to Santa Anita Derby winner Dinard and a half-brother to champion two-year-old filly Eliza (Mt. Livermore) has been retired to stud at Bonnie Heath Farm in Ocala, Florida. Raced by his breeder, Allen Paulson, the seven-year-old earned \$159,227 in winning four of 17 starts. Ojai's half-sister by Mr. Prospector topped last summer's Keeneland July sale at \$1,250,000. Ojai will stand for \$3,000 live foal.
