### TURFWAY, AQUEDUCT CANCEL LIVE CARDS

Turfway Park canceled live racing for both Saturday and Sunday, and Aqueduct called off its live program Saturday due to thawing conditions which rendered both tracks unsafe for competition. Both facilities, however, remained open for simulcast wagering. "Our track has an incredible amount of water in it," said Turfway President Mark Simendinger. "We're going to take this time to dry it out. The weather report for the next few days is for above-freezing temperatures which will allow our track crew to deal with the thaw and get as much water out of the track as possible." Joe King, who served as the New York Racing Association's track superintendent before retiring from that post last year, has been retained by Turfway to assist in the effort. Racing at the Kentucky oval is scheduled to resume Wednesday. Aqueduct is expected to hold its live program this afternoon. Saturday's feature, the Count Fleet S., was redrawn and will be run tomorrow. The track will be open Monday for Martin Luther King Day; originally scheduled to be dark Tuesday and Wednesday, it will make up one of the four days lost to bad weather this year with an extra card Wednesday. Entries for Wednesday's races will be taken today.

### NORTHERN SPUR READIES FOR RETURN

**Northern Spur (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), last year's champion Turf Horse after taking the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont, breezed a mile in 1:40 3/5 at Santa Anita yesterday and will make his '96 debut in the GII San Marcos H. January 21. The five-year-old, who missed the GI Hollywood Turf Cup December 10 after developing a cough, has recovered and is training well for his return, according to trainer Ron McAnally.

### GARDEN STATE OPENING POSTPONED AGAIN

Garden State Park has pushed back the opening of its 1996 Thoroughbred season and will now start the meet this Thursday night, January 18. "We'll have our track crews and outside contractors working the track around the clock in hopes of having it ready for training as quickly as possible," said General Manager Richard Orbann. "I think we're looking at maybe Monday morning. And if we don't get any more bad weather, it should be in great shape for Thursday night."

Making his main track debut off a game second-place finish in the GI Hollywood Derby November 26, Helmsman showed a pair of bullet works on the dirt at Hollywood and proved equally adept over the Santa Anita main oval. Backed down to 2-1 favoritism, the bay bobbed at the start but recovered to make a move at the leaders on the far turn, hooking Gold and Steel (Fr) in midstretch and proving best in the battle to the wire; the first three finishers all began their careers in Europe, and all were making their first starts on the dirt. "He certainly handled the dirt very well," said winning jockey Chris McCarron. "He stumbled leaving the gate, but he put himself in the race immediately...and when I asked him to run, this colt really punched." Added winning trainer Wally Dollase, "He had been working so easy, it's unbelievable. He's just a natural runner--he's so powerful and he's a very good-looking horse. But the number one ingredient is that this guy has got a lot of heart." Dollase added that his colt will start next in the GI Strub S. Feb. 4, as will runner-up Gold and Steel (Fr).

Halo's Image scored impressive back-to-back wins before tiring to finished second in the GIII Tropical Park H. in his last race. Ridden by Pat Day for the first time here, the dark bay stalked the early pace, rallied leaving the backstretch and took a slim lead on the final turn; he had to dig down deep to hold off Wekiva Springs at the finish. Day thought his mount had come up short at the wire. "I thought the other horse had won," he said. "We both kept down on our horses all the way around the turn before we slowed up. They were both all out." Trainer Happy Alter indicated the GI Donn H. (Feb. 10) could be next for his charge.

6th-GPX, \$38,000, Alw, 4yo/up, 7f, 1:23 2/5, ft. **PUNCH LINE** (g, 6, Two Punch--Hilarious Astro, by Fast Hilarious) was bumped and finished fourth in the Hallandale H. Jan. 3. Back off 10 days rest, the veteran runner was sent off at 6-1; he traveled six-wide while just behind the leaders, took the lead with a seven-wide move into the stretch and drew clear to win by 2 1/4 lengths. The five-year-old mare is one-for-one over the Santa Anita grass after taking the GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational November 12; she will try to bounce back after finishing seventh (but beaten only 1 3/4 lengths) in the GI Matriarch in her latest effort November 26. **Matiara** (Bering {GB}), a G1 winner in France, was second in the GII E. P. Taylor S. in her North American debut but finished ninth in the Matriarch after an eventful trip last out. The four-year-old gets jockey Gary Stevens in the irons for the first time. **Wandesta (GB)** (Nashwan), third in the Matriarch, took three straight, including a pair of Grade I events, over this course last year.
