**RECORD HANDLE AT FAIR GROUNDS** The Fair Grounds in New Orleans, Louisiana enjoyed the biggest one-day handle in its 124-year history yesterday as the total overall mutuel handle combining on-track and off-track facilities soared to \$3,456,248. It was the first time the track had surpassed the \$3-million mark. The on-track handle of \$322,045, added to \$3,134,203 wagered on the Fair Grounds card around the country, easily eclipsed the previous record of \$2,948,864 set March 13, 1988.

**SERENA'S SONG SHARP FOR RETURN** Last year's champion three-year-old filly **Serena's Song** (Rahy), away since finishing fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff October 28 in her first off-the-board performance since the Kentucky Derby, worked a bullet seven furlongs in 1:23 4/5 at Santa Anita yesterday. She remains on target for her four-year-old debut in the GI Santa Monica January 27. The Team Lukas runner will bid for her ninth Grade I victory in that event.

**FAIR GROUNDS PURSES RAISED** Fair Grounds President and General Manager Bryan G. Krantz has announced the track's first purse increase this season; beginning with Monday's card, all purses except stakes will be raised from \$700 to \$2,000 per race, with claiming events receiving the smallest supplement and allowance races the largest. Krantz attributed the purse hike to unlimited simulcasting from out-of-state tracks to the Fair Grounds and its off-track betting outlets across the state. At its December meeting, the Louisiana State Racing Commission approved a measure allowing Louisiana tracks to take the simulcasting signal from an unlimited number of out-of-state tracks; previously, only one out-of-state card could be shown against a live Louisiana program.

Cobra King won the GIII Hollywood Prevue in his last start, Nov. 19. Trying a distance for the first time, the colt stalked the early pace, gained the lead in the stretch, then dueled with Editor's Note before drawing off. Said winning trainer Mike Puype, "I was a little concerned because he was very hot before we saddled him. It is very humid, but that is why we brought him here early, to get him acclimated." As for the challenge of Editor's Note, Puype admitted, "You have to be scared any time a horse ranges up on you like that, especially as powerful as Editor's Note is. You just hope you are fit enough to go on with him." Puype said either the Fountain of Youth (Feb. 24) or the Florida Derby (March 16) would be next for Cobra King. Dallas Stewart, assistant to D. Wayne Lukas, said the Fountain of Youth would most likely be next for Editor's Note.

Cavonnier, who missed by just a head in the California Breeders' Championship to end his two-year-old season, got the nod in the photo this time. Racing just off the leaders through the opening fractions, the Cal-bred champion juvenile of '95 found another gear at the eighth pole to take the lead, then held off rank outsider Sergeant Stroh to win it under jockey Martin Pedroza. "This horse is getting better and better," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He's a very smart horse, but he's also very lazy. You've got to keep on him after he makes the lead." Baffert added that the colt would make one more start, then point for the Santa Anita Derby April 6. The 1-2 favorite CARA RAFAELA (Quiet American), taking on colts for the first time, moved up on the far turn but lacked a strong late kick. "She didn't break well and was slipping and sliding the whole way. She was flat shod and I could feel it. That's about the whole story," said her jockey, Gary Stevens.

Jockey Alex Solis picked up the mount on Jewel Princess when her scheduled rider, Goncalino Almeida, was injured in a spill in the day's second race. Rating the filly at the rear of the four-horse field early while staying close to the pace, the jock sent her up to challenge on the far turn and outgamed the pacesetter Sleep Easy late to take the victory. "I got my position and it was a waiting game," said Solis. "I waited and waited, just to make sure I had enough horse for the end. When I asked her, she really kicked on." Trainer Wally Dollase added that the filly would make her next start in the La Canada February 11. The 3-5 favorite Urbane, with the leaders from the start, weakened in the drive.

**MIDWEST TRACKS CLOSED** For the eighth time this year, Turfway Park was forced to call off its live racing program yesterday due to the weather. Bitter cold temperatures combined with significant wind chill factors were cited as cause for the cancellation. Simulcasting from Turfway's Race Book went on as scheduled, and live racing is expected to resume today with first post set for 1:00 p.m. Racing was also scrapped at Oaklawn Park yesterday, for the first time since the season opened January 12. The Arkansas oval is also expected to get back in action this afternoon; the first race is set for 1:00 p.m.
