CIGAR ON TARGET FOR DONN The juggernaut of '95 gave notice yesterday that he is ready to roll on his 1996 campaign; **Cigar** (Palace Music) breezed six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 3/5 at Gulfstream Park Monday as he continues to prepare for his return to the races in the GI Donn H. February 10. The bright bay, with jockey Jerry Bailey in the irons, worked after the second break over a fast main track as horsemen lined the rail to watch. "I think that was a pretty good work over this track," said trainer Bill Mott. "We weren't trying to break the watch, we were just trying to put a useful work into him, and that is what we got." The six-year-old goes for his 13th straight victory in the \$300,000 Donn, but Mott did not voice any superstitions when asked about keeping the streak alive. "If there was going to be any pressure, it was last year," he said. "I feel good about the way he is going, but...it would be very difficult to duplicate last year. Enough weight slows them all down."

PENNEKAMP EMBARKS FOR DUBAI Sheikh Mohammed's **Pennekamp** (Bering {GB}), is heading for Dubai to continue preparations for the March 27 Dubai World Cup. The winner of last year's 2000 Guineas left trainer Andre Fabre's Chantilly stable Monday morning and will remain under Fabre's supervision while in the United Arab Emirates. Pennekamp has not raced since injuring a leg while finishing 11th in last year's Epsom Derby. The Sheikh's racing manager Anthony Stroud said, "The horse is sound. He will have a prep race at the course (Nad Al Sheba) three weeks before the big one." The four-year-old is expected to be joined in the World Cup by his stablemate **Freedom Cry** (GB) (Soviet Star), runner-up in the Breeders' Cup Turf last Oct. 28.

SIX NEW BARNS AT KEENELAND Keeneland officials yesterday announced the construction of six new barns at the Lexington racetrack. Excavation has already started, and work is scheduled to be completed by August 15. The new barns, five with 40 stalls and one with 36 stalls, will increase the total number of stalls at Keeneland to 1,792. "The additional stalls will be particularly helpful during the September Yearling and November Breeding Stock sales," explained Keeneland Director of Sales Rogers Beasley. "It will allow us to stable horses on the grounds for four complete days of the sale."

ARGENTINE CHAMP TO FABRE Daniel Wildenstein has purchased **Ski Iberia (Arg)**, last year's champion three-year-old filly in Argentina and the winner of the Argentine Oaks, and will campaign her in Europe this year. Andre Fabre will train the Southern Hemisphere-bred filly, who is considered a four-year-old in Europe, but reported that she will not make her first start for her new connections until July or August when she actually turns four.

WILD HARMONY ARRIVES AT PIN OAK Sprinter **Wild Harmony (Wild Again)**, who stood the Southern Hemisphere breeding season at Muranna Stud in Victoria, Australia, has arrived at Pin Oak Stud in Versailles, Kentucky for American stud duty. The seven-year-old, a multiple-stakes winner of \$395,932, entered stud in 1995. He will stand the '96 season for a fee of \$4,000, live foal.
