CALIFORNIA BONUS LOOKS TO BE A 'GO'

After a meeting Thursday between heads of the three Southern California racetracks and management of the MGM Grand Casino, there is renewed optimism that the parties will come together to offer a \$1.8 million bonus tying together the Santa Anita H., Hollywood Gold Cup and Pacific Classic. "I'm pretty optimistic," said Santa Anita President and C.O.O. Cliff Goodrich yesterday. "We're down to the short strokes. We're hopeful there will be an announcement sometime this week. We're very close. I'd say it's 90-10." Goodrich also hopes that such a bonus will lure Cigar (Palace Music) to the California races, but said there has been no confirmation from owner Allen Paulson as to whether he will run his champion in the March 2 Santa Anita H. or the Gulfstream Park H. the same day.

CIGAR BREEZES, DONN FIELD GROWS Cigar (Palace Music) breezed a half-mile in :50 at Gulfstream Park yesterday en route to his '96 debut in the Feb. 10 Donn H. "When he turned down the backside, he hit a high gallop," said trainer Bill Mott. "The way he was picking up momentum, he must have had a clue that he was going to work." Cigar will breeze twice more before the Donn, with his next blowout scheduled for Wednesday. "The closer his works are and the more works he has, the fitter and sharper he gets," Mott said. "I'd like to give him a day off (Sunday)...if he acts too sharp, we'll have to go back to the track with him." The GI \$300,000 Donn picked up two more expected starters yesterday, including one from Cigar's own shedrow. Stablemate **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom) was scratched from yesterday's Canadian Turf H., which would have been his turf debut, to compete against Cigar on the dirt. "We discussed it and the owners were more interested in being second or third choice in the (Donn) than being second choice (to The Vid) in a Grade II, especially since he is unproven on the turf," said Mott. **Star Standard** (Risen Star), who won Friday's ninth race at Gulfstream, will also take on Cigar in the Donn, confirmed trainer Nick Zito. "His race was excellent, bigger than I expected," said the trainer, who conceded that his Belmont S. runner-up is facing an uphill battle. "Cigar is a great horse," Zito said. "You really can't help but think when you run against him you are running against greatness and all you can do is hope that somehow, with a little luck, it is your turn. But you can't approach it expecting to beat him."

Unraced since a fifth-place finish in the Oct. 28 Breeders' Cup Distaff, Serena's Song broke alertly and forced the early pace of Klassy Kim. Taking a short lead on the turn, she fought on the rail through the stretch to hold off Exotic Wood. Klassy Kim steadied while in tight between the top pair in midstretch, but a stewards' inquiry did not alter the outcome. The two daughters of Rahy were each sent off at even-money, with Serena's Song the actual betting choice. "This is one of the special ones," said winning trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "You don't come out of the woodwork like that and win GI races at seven-eighths. Seven-eighth races like this are very, very hard to win. I think she's going to go down in the books. She's got some big, big days ahead of her, I'm sure." Jockey Gary Stevens was equally impressed. "She just gives me goosebumps," he said. "Here she was, off three months, spotting weight, coming out of the one hole...everything was against her and she went out there and just basically overpowered them." Lukas said the Feb. 11 9-furlong La Canada S. at Santa Anita may be next for Serena's Song.

The Vid came into this race undefeated in three starts on the Gulfstream turf and off two straight GSW, the GIII Tropical Turf H. and the GIII Appleton in his last start Jan. 6. Rating behind the early lead, he took command in the stretch and drew off easily. Marty Wolfson was impressed with his charge's performance. "This horse is just awesome," said Wolfson. "He is such a cool horse to train. He probably won't run for six to eight weeks. We'll do whatever Mr. Sullivan wants. We'll talk about a lot of options." GAL IN A RUCKUS TO SABIN? Gal In A Ruckus (Bold Ruckus), who has not raced since finishing seventh, beaten 30 lengths, in last August's GI Alabama S. at Saratoga, may make her '96 debut in Wednesday's \$75,000 Sabin H. at Gulfstream. "She is doing super," said trainer John Ward of his GI Kentucky Oaks winner. "We have taken a methodical, slow approach with her." Ward said he estimates chances are 50/50 that she'll make the race.

PINK SHOES TO PRIVATE TERMS Pink Shoes

(Phone Trick), a MSW of \$121,877 whose racing career ended when she fractured a sesamoid last spring, will be bred to Private Terms this year after a long fight to save her life. "We tried so hard to keep from putting her to sleep," said her owner, Patricia Blass. "She was a good patient and seemed to understand the gravity of the situation." Blass said that an initial surgery, in which a tantalum-based alloy rod was placed in the sesamoid, had to be repeated when the rod snapped. The winner of Oaklawn's Martha Washington S. last spring, Pink Shoes still wears a small cast on her right foreleg, but has recovered sufficiently to be bred.
