UNBRIDLED'S SONG IN FINAL HUTCHESON

PREP Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) drilled five furlongs in :58 2/5 Sunday at Gulfstream in preparation for his three-year-old debut in Saturday's GII \$75,000 Hutcheson Stakes. Regular rider Mike Smith was aboard the Breeders' Cup Juvenile champ as the duo turned in the fastest work of the morning for that distance. "That's it," trainer Jim Ryerson said. "He may open gallop, but he won't work again before the race, especially since he went so fast. We wanted to get a good work into him and we got it." In the middle of the gray colt's work, another horse inadvertently joined in with Unbridled's Song, adding to but not causing the colt's quick fractions, according to Ryerson. "He was going to work fast today anyway," said the trainer. "He seemed to be more on the muscle and looking to work from the outset." Ryerson is pleased with the Kentucky-bred's progress and remains confident about his chances in the seven-furlong Hutcheson. "I expect him to run well like he usually does," he said. "Hopefully he will come out of it good and we will go forward from there. It is not always easy to bring a horse back after giving them time off and he seems to have come back well. He is a big horse and it took him a while. The last three weeks, he has really picked it up. It is nice to be at this point, but now he has to show it in the afternoon."

TRF AUCTION A SUCCESS The Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation held its 1996 Stallion Season and Art Auction Saturday at Herb and Ellen Moelis's Candyland Farm in Middletown, Delaware. "Between 250 and 300 people showed up," said Herb Moelis, "and we raised around \$250,000 to \$270,000." Moelis indicated yesterday that the exact amount raised had not yet been determined. The top stallion season sold was a 1996 no guarantee season to Wild Again, which brought \$38,000. The proceeds benefit the non-profit TRF which provides a home for Thoroughbreds after their racing careers are over at its New York and Maryland Farms. The New Bolton Center of the University of Pennsylvania will also be a recipient of funds generated by the Auction.

Raw Gold, winner of the six-furlong Althea S. in her most recent effort December 10, stretched out a furlong and completed the Rahy Santa Anita stakes double for the weekend, vying with Pareja to the eighth pole before driving clear under jockey Chris Antley. "This little filly has matured so much in the past year that seven-eighths is an okay distance right now," said trainer David Hofmans. "She got hooked every step of the way and had enough to finish strong. She was an absolute baby when we were at Hollywood Park--she has a better mind now." Hofmans added that the GI Las Virgenes at a mile February 18 could be next; runner-up Pareja is also pointing for that race. Previously undefeated PIKE PLACE DANCER (Seattle Dancer) ran evenly to be fourth.

Lotta Dancing, who rallied from way back to be third in the Woodhaven H. at Aqueduct in her last start Jan. 6, was sent off the 3-1 second choice here to notch her first stakes victory. The bay mare raced toward the back of the six-horse field early, rapidly gained while inside on the final turn, swung out approaching the quarter pole, took the lead in midstretch then drew away for the victory. "She ran a really good race today," said Buzz Tenney, assistant to trainer Shug McGaughey. "It set up good with the (fast) pace and she was sharp today--even early on in the race. She was supposed to be leaving for Florida at 6 a.m. tomorrow (Monday), but that can change." The 3-5 favorite RESTORED HOPE (He's Bad), winner of seven of her eight previous starts, including a pair of GIII events at Aqueduct last year, forced the pace early then was eased late to finish 6th and last in the only off-the-board performance of her career.

Rated near the back of the pack early, the winner of last year's GI Super Derby found himself trapped behind horses on the far turn and hit the temporary rail while looking for room at the top of the stretch but managed to bull his way through and outgamed River Majesty in the drive to take the four-way photo. "The temporary rail on the inside has a bit of a bend in it, and I hit it slightly but he still closed well," said winning jockey Shane Sellers. As for the future, trainer Manny Tortora said, "We're thinking about the Gulfstream Park H. (March 2). This race should get salty. (Mecke) runs on dirt, grass, whatever. I couldn't tell which he is better on. He just loves to run."

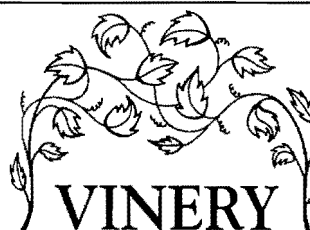
