CHAIN SMOKING: CIGAR'S STREAK

CONTINUES He was going for his 13th straight victory, but the way 1995 Horse of the Year **Cigar** (Palace Music) looked yesterday, he could have strolled under a ladder and stopped to break a mirror and still galloped to another easy score in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park. Returning to the scene of last year's first Grade I win, the bright bay with the crooked blaze bounced out of the paddock and bounded to the starting gate but put it into cruise control for the race itself, stalking the pace through honest early fractions before asserting himself as the leader of this pack; he turned back a mild challenge from fellow Bill Mott trainee **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom) at the top of the lane to win in hand under a supremely confident and virtually motionless Jerry Bailey. "He was ready to go today," said Mott. "Coming over here, he acted very professionally. He knew what he had to do, and he did his job. Wekiva Springs gave me a little thrill there--when he came to Cigar at the quarter-pole, I was hoping I wouldn't have to start my mail room job tomorrow. Wekiva Springs ran a great race, but he wasn't good enough to beat Cigar." Looking towards the future, Mott said, "Right now, we are leaning towards the Santa Anita H. as our next objective. Provided he comes back good and he is sound and he wants to do it again, that is where we are going." While Cigar's margin of victory was only two lengths, Mott has a hunch where his champ will stand when the weights come out for the Big 'Cap. "He won pretty easily," he said. "I could play all those games with the handicappers, but they are not blind. Eventually, if there is enough of a spread, the weight will make a difference." Cigar's victory created a minus show pool of \$98,539.58, the largest in Gulfstream history; the previous record of \$21,699.95 was set March 8, 1982, when Distinctive Pro won the Hutcheson S. **News cont. p2**

Making 1-5 look like a generous price, Horse of the Year Cigar returned from a three-and-a-half month vacation looking every inch the champion. On his toes in the post parade, the bay was taken in hand by jockey Jerry Bailey at the break, settled behind pace-setters **FLYING CHEVRON** (Carson City) and **STAR STANDARD** (Risen Star) for three-quarters, then eased to the outside and took the lead at will; stable-mate **Wekiva Springs** joined him at the top of the stretch, but while jockey Mike Smith went to work on the grey, Bailey sat chilly and Cigar drew clear under his own power as his rider never even moved his hands. "I had a bit of trouble at the first turn," said Bailey, who picked up his first Eclipse Award last night in California. "It got tight in there, but once I got him out it was another typical race for him. The weight never bothered him at all." The winner was giving his rivals from 11 to 18 pounds. Trainer Bill Mott said that while Cigar is likely to head west for the Santa Anita H. March 2, runner-up **Wekiva Springs** will make his next start in the GI Gulfstream Park H. on the same day. **Heavenly Prize**, also making her first start since the Breeders' Cup, settled near the back of the pack early and made up some ground late to finish a non-threatening third; trainer Shug McGaughey said the filly would be back to take on the boys again in the Gulfstream Park H. **Flying Chevron** tired from his early efforts to finish fifth; the four-year-old collapsed after the race while suffering from heat prostration but recovered to return to his barn; he was reported as out of immediate danger.

HERB AND ELLEN MOELIS: JANUARY'S COBRA/TDN SUBSCRIBERS OF THE MONTH

Herb and Ellen Moelis, who made the news after hosting the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation's Stallion Season and Art Auction for the sixth straight year January 27, have been named the inaugural winners of the Cobra Golf/*Thoroughbred Daily News* Subscribers of the Month Award. The owners of Delaware's CandyLand Farm became involved with the TRF "seven or eight years ago," said Herb Moelis. "Allaire DuPont, who was the founder of the organization, set up a meeting in the Chesapeake City area, and I made the mistake of saying a couple of things--before I knew it, I was chairman." The auction was started in 1991. "We had to raise funds, and this was the logical way to do it," he explained. "We've worked hard at it. The first year, we had maybe 10 seasons in all; 25 people came and we held the auction in our living room. It just grew from there. Now we get a tent and attach it to the house--and we had a sun room added last year, strictly to accommodate the auction." Approximately 275 people attended this year's fundraiser, bidding nearly \$300,000 for the 150 seasons and art objects offered. The money will go to the TRF and to the New Bolton Center at the University of Pennsylvania. As for being honored as the Subscriber of the Month, Moelis said, "We were very surprised--it was quite a shock. It's also quite a thrill; we are very appreciative. The funny thing is that I used to play an awful lot of golf, before we got into the horse business. Now I have the incentive to play again." Cobra Golf Chairman and owner/breeder Gary Bizzantz said, "We are delighted to recognize the contributions, highlighted by last month's TRF auction, that Herb and Ellen Moelis have made to our industry. We hope that between their work at CandyLand and their charitable enterprises, they have the time to enjoy their new golf clubs." The Moelises will have their choice of a set of King Cobra, Senior King Cobra or Lady Cobra Oversize steel-shaft irons and woods.

Sleep Easy (Seattle Slew) came back after a two-month vacation to set the pace in the GII El Encino January 20; the Juddmonte homebred held well for second while giving the 2 1/2-length winner, **Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint), two pounds. She should benefit from the race and the slight weight shift. Juddmonte stablemate **Privity** (Private Account) tries dirt for the first time in her first start of the year.
