THE VID INJURED Joseph Sullivan's multiple graded-stakes winner **The Vid** (World Appeal) suffered a fracture of the right front sesamoid during a workout at Gulfstream yesterday and is likely to be retired. Sullivan said he and trainer Marty Wolfson would send the x-rays to another veterinarian for a second opinion, but it appears the six-year-old's racing career is over. Undeclared in two starts this year, the Florida-bred, who was named for Sullivan's close friend, Arnold Vorda, made his last start in the GIII Appleton H. at Gulfstream January 27; he has won 13 of 39 career starts and \$937,626. Sullivan added that, even if **The Vid** is retired this year, he will not go to stud until 1997.

COBRA KING SHARP AT GULFSTREAM Cobra King (Farma Way), winner of the GIII Holy Bull S. in his three-year-old debut, worked five furlongs in 1:01 under jockey Shane Sellers at Gulfstream yesterday morning. "I want to take my time and not push him too hard," said trainer Mike Puype, who is leaning towards running the colt in the GI Florida Derby March 16 next. "He seems to do really good the further he gets away from his races. He is just now starting to pick it up again (after his Holy Bull win). He puts a lot into what he does. If he were to run in the Fountain of Youth (February 24), he might get tired and it might affect us in the Florida Derby, which is our focus. We want to go into that race 100 percent, instead of maybe 80 percent." **News cont. p2**

BARBARA FRITCHIE H.-GII, \$200,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 7f
 GISW **Chaposa Springs** (Baldski), who scratched from the GIII Shirley Jones H. when the track came up muddy, rates highweight of 123 pounds. The four-year-old has been first or second in 15 of 17 starts, and rides a two-race winning streak into this stakes. **Morris Code** (Lost Code), 119, ships in from the Fair Grounds after taking the American Beauty S. at Oaklawn in her season opener. The expected field of 12 also includes **Lottsa Talc** (Talc), 117; **Traverse City** (Halo), 117; **Cormorant's Flight** (Cormorant), 116; **Lucky Lavender Gal** (Carson City), 113; **Clever Act** (Gulch), 112; **Denied Access** (Cryptoclearance), 112; **I'll Get Along** (Smile), 112; **Lulu** (Afleet), 110; and **Forested** (Country Pine), 109.

Sunday, Gulfstream Park

DEPUTY MINISTER H., \$50,000, 3yo/up, 6f
Not Surprising (Medieval Man), last year's champion sprinter, makes his first start of the year Sunday. The six-year-old, fourth in the Breeders' Cup Sprint in his last start of '95, shoulders highweight of 123 pounds for his return. A \$7,200 Ocala Breeders Sales Company yearling, the gelding has won 18 races while bankrolling \$901,073. "Once we gelded him, that's when we found his true ability," said his trainer, Judson Van Worp. "He has always been a sound horse who tries hard." Also possible for the race is millionaire **Friendly Lover** (Cutlass), 118, third in the Olympic H. in his '96 debut and also nominated to Laurel's General George.

Monday, Laurel Park

GENERAL GEORGE H.-GII, \$200,000, 3yo/up, 7f
Meadow Monster (Meadowlake), impressive winner of two stakes in his two starts at Gulfstream this year, has been supplemented to the General George for \$3,000 and will share top weight of 120 pounds in the race with **Foxie G.** (Horatius). The five-year-old Meadow Monster is expected to ship to Maryland Wednesday; Rick Wilson rides Saturday. **Foxie G.**, a Maryland-based five-year-old trained by Dale Capuano, is also two-for-two in 1996; he looks for his fourth consecutive Laurel stakes victory. Also probable for the race: **Sunny Sunrise** (Sunny's Halo), 115; **Sea Emperor** (Naked Sky), 113; **Mary's Buckaroo** (Roo Art), 112; **Jealous Crusader** (Crusader Sword), 110; **Jed Forest** (Gold Alert), 110; **Higher Strata** (Afleet), 109; **Marry Me Do** (Blushing Groom {Fr}), 109; **Splendid Sprinter** (Valid Appeal), 109; and **Yappy** (Herat), 108.

SWINBURN UPDATE Jockey Walter Swinburn was listed in serious but stable condition and remains in intensive care at the Prince of Wales Hospital in Hong Kong yesterday, where he underwent two operations, one to ease pressure under his skull and the other to drain fluid from his lungs. Swinburn was injured in a spill Sunday at Sha Tin Racecourse in Hong Kong. The 34-year-old winner of three Epsom Derbies, including last year's win on Lammtarra, was catapulted into a stanchion when his mount, **Liffey River** (Irish River {Fr}) collided with the running rails. X-rays revealed several broken ribs, a multiple fracture of his left collar-bone, a broken left shoulder and internal bruising. A spokesman for the Royal Hong Kong Jockey Club said Monday, "Walter is expected to make a full recovery and he should be able to ride again by mid-summer. His doctors' main concern is fluid on his lungs, but I am certain they are doing all they can to help him."

FIRST FOAL FOR FURIOUSLY Mr. and Mrs. Ben P. Walden, Jr.'s Vinery has announced the arrival of the first foal by GISW **Furiously** (Danzig). The foal, a filly out of MSW Bionic Soul, was born February 9 at the Midway, Kentucky farm. After experiencing fertility problems at the beginning of the 1995 season in his first year as a sire, **Furiously** did get 14 mares in foal. He stands the 1996 season at Vinery at private treaty.

FHBPA REACHES CONTRACT SETTLEMENTS Executive Director Kent Stirling reported yesterday that the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association has successfully concluded settlement negotiations with 36 of the 73 off-track betting outlets that will protect the interests of Florida horsemen during the upcoming 1996 meet at Hialeah Park. The FHBPA filed an action in Miami federal court last June against Hialeah and 75 casinos, racetracks and other off-track betting systems after Hialeah allegedly violated the 1995 FHBPA contract and underpaid purses to horsemen during the 1995 race meet. During the past six months, the FHBPA has conducted significant settlement negotiations with many of the out-of-state betting outlets, some of which have agreed they will not take interstate wagers on Hialeah races without the consent of the FHBPA. "We are pleased at the number of receiving outlets who understand the concept of the Interstate Horseracing Act and the rights it bestows upon horsemen," stated Stirling.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

CEZZANE FOURTH IN DUBAI Cezzane (GB) (Ajdal), one of four Godolphin horses nominated to the March 27 Dubai World Cup, finished fourth in the first leg of the Maktoum Challenge at Nad Al Sheba Racecourse in Dubai Sunday night. Cezzane, a graded stakes winner in Germany and Ireland, was making his first start in 15 months in the one-mile race and is expected to improve with added distance. The seven-year-old's stablemate **Tamayaz** (Gone West) confirmed his place among the reserves for the Dubai World Cup with his decisive three-length win in the race. Rounding out the top three in the first round of the Maktoum Challenge were **Wathink** (Ogygian) and **Dover Straits** (Riverman).

THISTLEDOWN STAKES WORTH \$1.29 MILLION Thistledown's 1996 racing season opens Friday, March 1 and will feature 28 stakes races worth a total of \$1,290,000. The season's highlight will be the GII \$300,000 Ohio Derby Sunday, June 23. For the first time this year, the Thistledown Breeders' Cup will be run as a graded race. The race's new Grade III status makes it and the Derby the only two graded events on the Ohio racing calendar.

Editor's Note (Forty Niner), runner-up in the GIII Holy Bull S. last time out, breezed six furlongs in a bullet 1:11 4/5 under regular rider Jerry Bailey Monday; he will make his next start in the Fountain of Youth February 24. "The race is in a couple of weeks, and it was time to bear down," said Dallas Stewart, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He responded great. He is definitely a lot more focused than he was last time. He is right where we want him to be." Team Lukas will also send out impressive Gulfstream allowance winner **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) in the Fountain of Youth; jockey Gary Stevens picks up the mount.
