DANEWIN VICTORIOUS IN AUSTRALIA Prepping for the \$4 million Dubai World Cup March 27, **Danewin (Aus)** (Danehill) carried top weight of 132 pounds to a neck victory over **MGSW Sprint By (NZ)** (Kaaftad {NZ}) in the six-furlong Truscott's Fleet H. at Rosehill Gardens in Australia Saturday. The four-year-old, one of three Australian representatives expected for the World Cup, was ridden by jockey Wayne Harris, who subbed for regular rider Damien Oliver. Danewin paid \$3.90 (Australian) as the odds-on choice. Oliver will back on board last year's Australian champion three-year-old in Dubai.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH NOTES **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), twice second in Grade I company at two and winner of a Gulfstream allowance race February 3 in his first start in nearly five months, breezed five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 yesterday morning and could make his next start in the GII Fountain of Youth February 24. "He went great," said trainer Nick Zito. "He finished up great. He seems to do it all so easily." The colt would be making his first start beyond a mile and his first around two turns Saturday. "I would prefer to run in another spot around two turns, but we'll see what happens," said Zito. "I'm confident he'll handle it. I don't think it will pose a problem for him." Also prepping for the Fountain of Youth Saturday, Team Lukas runner **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) went five-eighths in 1:00 3/5. The dark bay has won his last three starts, all allowance events, and finished third in the GIII Tremont Breeders' Cup S. in his only stakes appearance. "We feel he will be a major player in these upcoming races," said Dallas Stewart, assistant to D. Wayne Lukas. "He looks like he will run all day--he never seems to get tired." The colt tried a distance of ground in his last start and won off by 11 1/2 lengths. Stablemate **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner), who will also run in the Fountain of Youth, is set to breeze Monday.

NORTHERN EMERALD TO A.P. INDY **Northern Emerald** (Green Dancer), who missed by just a head when second in last Wednesday's GIII The Very One H. at Gulfstream, will make the final start of her career in the GII Orchid H. March 10 before being retired to the breeding shed. The six-year-old mare, winner of the GI Flower Bowl Invitational and GII Vineland H. last year, has already bankrolled \$435,755 while winning eight of her 27 career starts. She will be bred to A.P. Indy.

Stretching out off her determined victory in the GI Santa Monica H. at seven furlongs January 27, champion **Serena's Song** again displayed her award-winning ability to run her Santa Anita record to a perfect six-for-six. Rated off the flank of pacesetter **KLASSY KIM** (Silent Screen) early, the classy bay moved to take the lead on the final bend and drove clear in the stretch, holding off second choice **Twice The Vice** under a Gary Stevens hand ride. "She is something else," said Stevens. "She accelerated at the half-mile pole with such a burst that it just set me back in the saddle. Her acceleration is simply unbelievable." As for what's next, trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "I'm going to talk it over with Mr. Lewis. I'm not going to say (the March 2 Santa Anita H.) is totally out of the question. Probably the logical step is the Santa Margarita (March 10). But you know, we dare to be great once in a while, and we want her to do that, too. I think we'll look at it seriously."

Dropping three pounds off her second-place effort in the Berlio H. at Aqueduct last time out, Lottsa Talc got her first win of the year in her third start. Rated in seventh through fractions of :22 2/5 and :45, the New York-bred mare found running room to reach the leaders at the top of the stretch and outfinished the consistent Up An Eighth for the win under new jockey Frank Alvarado. "On her best day, she's one of the best sprinting fillies around," said trainer Tim Kelly. "Today was one of her best days." French Derby winner Celtic Arms, winless in nine previous starts in the U.S. after going three-for-10 with two G1 wins in France, had shown flashes of brilliance in the States with a game second-place finish in last year's G1 Caesar's International H. and a third in the G1 Turf Classic. A well-beaten fourth trying the dirt for the first time in the GII San Marcos H. over a sloppy track January 21, the French import rebounded and finally found the American winner's circle, closing from the middle of the pack to hook fellow European Broadway Flyer at the top of the lane, then edging clear in the drive under jockey Mike Smith. "I was sitting in a good position," said Smith. "It might have looked like I was boxed in, but really I waited. You just have to have luck to win a race like this, and finally I found room. When I asked him, he accelerated." The winner will make his next start in the GII Pan American H. March 9.

MOONHELL READY FOR RETURN Moonshell (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of last year's G1 Epsom Oaks, is expected to make her comeback in next Sunday's second leg of the Maktoum Challenge at Nad Al Sheba in Dubai. The four-year-old has not run since her Classic triumph, but her connections are satisfied that she is now in top form and plan to start her in next weekend's mile-and-a-half event as her final prep for the March 27 Dubai World Cup. British champion jockey Frankie Dettori has the mount on the filly, whose only other start last season saw her third to Harayir in Newmarket's 1000 Guineas.

GARDEN STATE, PHILLY PARK CANCEL Racing at Garden State Park in Cherry Hill, New Jersey was called off for the second straight night Saturday due to the latest winter storm to hit the area. It is the seventh weather-related cancellation for Garden State since it opened its 1996 meet January 12. The Saturday afternoon simulcasting program went on as scheduled; live racing will resume Wednesday night. The live card was also canceled at Philadelphia Park yesterday; that track is scheduled to get back in action this afternoon.
