SERENA'S SONG POSSIBLE FOR BIG 'CAP

Robert and Beverly Lewis' **Serena's Song** (Rahy), now the 10th all-time distaff money-earner with \$2,314,855 in the bank, came out of Saturday's GI Santa Maria H. triumph in good order and could make her next start in the GI Santa Anita H. March 2. "She's doing fine, really good," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas yesterday. "She always seems to bounce back quickly." As for the Big 'Cap, Lukas said, "A big factor in this deal is the bonus. One of Serena's Song's biggest attributes is her durability. I would say she'd have a better chance of making all three of the races (in the MGM Grand Classic Crown) than Cigar. If the races were all a mile-and-an-eighth, I'd call Bob (Lewis) and say 'Let's go for it.' But that extra eighth of a mile will be the one thing we have to seriously consider." Definite for the \$1 million event, **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene) breezed five-eighths in an easy 1:05 at Hollywood Sunday morning; the five-year-old has two GI wins under his belt in two starts this year. Trainer Gary Jones said yesterday that he plans to start both **Kingdom Found** (The Bart) and **Luthier Fever** (Mt. Livermore) in the Big 'Cap.

GAL IN A RUCKUS BOUND FOR RAMPART?

Double Oaks winner **Gal In A Ruckus** (Bold Ruckus), second in a Gulfstream allowance February 10 in her first start in six months, could make her next appearance in the GI Rampart H. at Gulfstream Sunday. The four-year-old filly won four-of-six 1995 outings including the GI Kentucky Oaks and the Canadian Oaks. "I was pleased with her first race back," said trainer John Ward, Jr. "She ought to improve off that race. The timing is close (for the Rampart) and the spread of weights does not come out in our favor, but there is a chance. We are planning a very deliberate campaign, with her races well-spaced. It is a long season and our goal is the Breeders' Cup. We'll pick our spots as we go." Looking to give trainer Shug McGaughey his second straight Rampart score, **Recognizable** (Seattle Slew), already a two-time graded-stakes winner at Gulfstream, breezed six furlongs in 1:14 yesterday morning. The five-year-old, who had chips removed from her left front knee last summer, came back from an eight-month layoff January 31 to take a seven-furlong allowance test by a nose. She stretches out for the mile-and-a-sixteenth Rampart, a race in which she finished second to stablemate **Educated Risk** (Mr. Prospector) last year.

Trying dirt for only the second time in her career, Antepend followed a victory in the listed Santa Ysabel S. January 24 in her main track debut with her first Grade I score. The speedy bay filly jumped out to the lead through fractions of :22 2/5 and :46 3/5 and was never seriously challenged, opening it up when asked at the quarter-pole to win comfortably. "I didn't expect to be on the lead today," said jockey Chris Antley. "I thought for sure RAW GOLD (Rahy) would be the lone leader and I'd be in the second flight, hopefully not being trapped. (After the break) I went ahead and let out a notch because I didn't want to get caught in traffic...she got to the lead so quick, it shocked me." Trainer Ron McAnally said, "She's about as good as I've seen for a three-year-old filly. She's very versatile--grass and dirt. We've never run her in the mud, but she'll probably like that, too." The filly will make her next start in the Santa Anita Oaks March 10. The 4-5 favorite **Cara Rafaela**, fourth for a half, made her bid at the top of the lane but had to settle for second. "I didn't have any excuses," said her rider, Gary Stevens. "My filly ran a game race. I was thinking down the backside that I had (Antepend) any time I wanted her...she just kept finding more." The runner-up will also point for the Santa Anita Oaks.

Meadow Monster (Meadowlake) picks up three pounds off an impressive 5 1/2-length victory in the Olympic H. last time out. The five-year-old has now won his last three starts; he is three-for-five at seven furlongs. **Finder's Fortune** (Buckfinder) ships in from California off a second-place finish in the Reb's Policy S. on the grass January 21. The veteran seven-year-old returns to the dirt after hitting the board in eight of nine starts last year, including a third in the G3 Hong Kong International Bowl. **Splendid Sprinter** (Valid Appeal) steps up after back-to-back allowance wins at Aqueduct. The four-year-old has never been off the board in 10 career starts.

GOLD FEVER SHARP AT GULFSTREAM Pointing to Saturday's GII Fountain of Youth S., **Gold Fever** (Forty Niner) breezed six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 4/5 at Gulfstream Sunday morning. The Shug McGaughey trainee finished third in the GII Hutcheson S. last out in his first start of the season; he tries two turns for the first time in the mile-and-a-sixteenth Fountain of Youth. "I'm just hoping he got enough out of his last race," said McGaughey. "I hadn't trained him that hard and there wasn't much of a pace in there. He wants to drop back and make one run. He had to get into that race earlier than I would have liked. He acted to me like he wanted to try stretching out, and that was something I hadn't seen before." McGaughey three-year-old **Roar** (Forty Niner) invited attention with his eight-and-a-half length tally in Saturday's ninth race at Gulfstream; the trainer said the colt will make his next start in the GIII Swale S. March 16.

Jockey Jorge Chavez became the first rider in more than four years to win six races on a New York card when he accomplished the feat at Aqueduct Sunday afternoon, taking the first, third, fourth, sixth, eighth and 11th races on the program. It was the 13th time a New York jockey has picked up a half-dozen victories in a single day, but the first time Chavez had done it. The last rider to record six wins in a day at a New York track was Mike Smith, who reached that goal January 30, 1992; he had also ridden six winners January 13, 1992.

A memorial service for Herb Phipps, a newspaperman, author and publicist who helped Bay Meadows founder Bill Kyne get pari-mutuel wagering on horse racing legalized in California, will be held today at 2:00 p.m. at the Woodside Village Church in Woodside. Phipps died Wednesday at his home in San Mateo Wednesday after a battle with lung cancer. He was 90. Phipps was hired by Kyne in 1932 to handle the publicity campaign to legalize pari-mutuel gambling on horses in the Golden State; the campaign proved successful when California voters approved Proposition 5 June 27, 1933. A resident of San Mateo since 1950, Phipps is survived by his wife, Evelyn, three sons, 14 grandchildren and 22 great grandchildren.
