### CIGAR ON THE IMPROVE BUT

**UNLIKELY FOR BIG 'CAP** Cigar (Palace Music) missed another day of training yesterday due to the abscess in his right front foot and, although he is improving, trainer Bill Mott said yesterday that a trip to Santa Anita is a longshot. "He's better," said Mott. "(The abscess) is opened up and draining. He is much more comfortable, having had that pressure taken out. At least we are on our way to recovery now." But as for the March 2 Santa Anita H., Mott said, "We'd have to be rolling pretty quick, at least by the weekend. I don't really see that happening. There was no thought of taking him to the racetrack (Friday). I can't imagine him going (today). Even though he is more comfortable, he is not ready to train. In all reality, it looks pretty bleak. From my experience, it takes time for the inflammation to calm down."

### SERENA'S STATUS UNAFFECTED BY CIGAR

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said yesterday that Cigar's (Palace Music) possible defection from the March 2 Santa Anita H. will have no bearing on whether or not he will run **Serena's Song** (Rahy) in the \$1 million race. Lukas said that a more important factor was the weight Serena's Song will be assigned, and that he would not make any final decision until the weights are released Sunday. "I've got to know that I've got a legitimate chance to win because there's a Grade I she could run in a week later," said Lukas, referring to the March 10 nine-furlong Santa Margarita at Santa Anita. "I told the racing secretary she's never won at a mile and a quarter and for us to try to do something like this, we have to look at the weight and know that it's handicapped in a way that she's got a fair chance."

**SWINBURN RELEASED** Jockey Walter Swinburn, badly injured in a spill at Sha Tin racecourse two weeks ago, was released from Hong Kong's Prince of Wales Hospital yesterday. The three-time Epsom Derby winner, who sustained fractures of the collarbone, shoulder and ribs in the accident, is now walking without assistance. He has been passed fit enough to fly to Dubai next week for a period of convalescence before making a return to race-riding in April or May. "Walter must still take things quietly," said his father, Wally. "But his lungs are A1, or nearly, and it's just the bones which need to heal now before he can ride again."

**Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) was scratched from the Fountain of Youth to await an allowance race at the same distance Monday. **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) figures to improve off his three-year-old debut, where he was gaining at the end of the GII Hutcheson S. February 4 and came up just a half-length short. The colt tries two turns for the first time; he won the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at the Fountain of Youth distance going around one turn at Belmont Park. **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister), looking for his fourth straight, moved up with an 11-length score in his first try at a route of ground last out. Gary Stevens has ridden the colt once before, finishing a well-beaten third in a Belmont allowance test last fall. *The Fountain Of Youth will be televised live on ESPN from 4:30-5:30 p.m. EST.*

**News cont.****HONOR THE HERO RETIRED** Honor The Hero

(Hero's Honor), a 12-time stakes winner and three-time graded-stakes winner, has been retired. The eight-year-old made his last start at Turf Paradise, site of his most memorable performances, in the Roadrunner H. February 3; he finished eighth as the 1-2 favorite in his first start since last June. "He just hasn't come back this year the way we hoped," said trainer Doug Oliver. "He's older now...I wanted to retire him with his good name intact. The owners are in agreement with the decision." The gelding won 25 of his 58 career starts, and equaled the world record for six furlongs in 1993 with a 1:06 4/5 clocking at Turf Paradise; he won the last race of his '95 campaign, taking the Renville County H. at Canterbury last June 18.

**TURFWAY ANNOUNCES SECOND PURSE HIKE**

For the second time since the first of the year, Turfway Park officials have announced an across-the-board purse increase. The 5-percent raise took effect with Thursday night's card, and raises Turfway's daily average purse distribution to an estimated \$252,000. With the latest increase, the minimum purse at the Florence, Kentucky track is \$7,000 for \$4,000 claimers going six furlongs; top allowance races with open conditions will now carry a purse of \$51,600.
