BUILT FOR PLEASURE LIGHTS UP THE BOARD IN FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH It looked like Breeders' Cup champ **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) had it measured, holding **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) safe as the two drove to the wire, but it was 143-1 shot **Built for Pleasure** (Homebuilder) who brought down the house. Racing down the stretch on his wrong lead, the bay joined the leaders inside the final furlong and snatched the victory from the favorite in a three-way photo. "We have been teaching him to make that big late run and he really kicked in today," said winning jockey Gary Boulanger. "I rode him with a lot of confidence...he is the kind of horse who makes you believe in him." Owner/trainer Thomas Heard purchased the colt for \$40,000 from last year's Fasig-Tipton two-year-old-in-training sale at Calder. "I trained his grandmother, and won five or six stakes with her," said Heard. "That got me interested in looking at him. He didn't look like much then, but I thought if he had his grandmother's heart, he'd be all right." As for the future, Heard said, "I had thought that the Florida Derby was going to be too tough for us because I have thought for some time that Unbridled's Song is the best horse in the country. I may have to change plans now." Trainer Jim Ryerson was not unhappy with his colt's second-place finish. "Considering it was his first race around two turns, and that he had a little trouble in the first turn, I wasn't discouraged." Added his jockey, Mike Smith, "They piled up in front of him--it was pretty rough going into the first turn. I was forced to go around. Once he's able to relax a little better, he'll finish better. He'll go forward from this race." The top three could meet again in the Florida Derby March 16.

CIGAR OUT OF BIG 'CAP Cigar (Palace Music), still only walking after having an abscess removed from his right front foot Thursday, could be back on track as early as Wednesday but will be forced to skip next Saturday's \$1 million Santa Anita H. Trainer Bill Mott had said that if his stable star was not back in training by this weekend, he would miss the race. Remarking on the 1995 Horse of the Year's progress, Mott said yesterday, "He does seem to be a little tender, but he's 90 percent improved. He's not 100 percent yet, but well on his way." Cigar's status for the March 27 Dubai World Cup is up in the air. "With one week of training lost, I still think he can make it," Mott said.

 Second in two of his three previous graded stakes tries and on-the-board in seven-of-nine lifetime, Built For Pleasure was nevertheless sent off a rank outsider at 143-1. The bay settled in sixth for six furlongs, then moved to the outside under jockey Gary Boulanger and wore down 4-5 Unbridled's Song in a shocker. "Everyone in my stable liked this horse and bet on him today," said owner/trainer Thomas Heard. "This is not a fluke race. He is a nice colt. It meant a lot to me to beat a horse like Unbridled's Song." The runner-up, making his second start since the Breeders' Cup, was in traffic on the first turn; he moved up to sit off the flank of 144-1 pacesetter GOMTUU (Hail The Ruckus) to the far turn, then put a head in front and battled all the way to the wire to just miss.

HENNESSY INJURED Hennessy (Storm Cat), runner-up in last year's Grade I Breeders' Cup Juvenile and unraced since a fourth-place finish in the GI Hollywood Futurity December 17, has suffered a bruised right front foot and could be out of training for up to two months. The three-year-old, winner of the GI Hopeful and GI Sapling and Hollywood Juvenile Championship at two, is currently at trainer D. Wayne Lukas' Santa Ynez farm.

CHRB BACKS CALIFORNIA BILL The California Horse Racing Board has announced its sponsorship of Senate Bill 2000, which was introduced Friday by Senator Ken Maddy. SB 2000 would establish a state license fee rate, the fee paid by tracks to the state, that would never be higher than the average rate of the eight other major racing states. "The California horse racing industry currently pays the highest effective tax rate of any business in the state, and more than any other state in the country," said CHRB Chairman Ralph Scurfield and Vice Chairman Donald Valpreo in a joint statement of the Board's Legislative Committee. "By bringing California's license fee in line with the other major racing states, we will be providing greater incentives for horse owners to race their horses in our state and taking steps to preserve and enhance this vital industry."
