DEPUTY MINISTER COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON TWO-YEAR-OLDS

Bringing a final bid of \$230,000, a chestnut colt by Deputy Minister--Secret Red (Secretariat) topped the first session of Fasig-Tipton's Selected Two-year-olds In Training Sale, which began yesterday at Calder. Consigned by Sequel Bloodstock, Inc., agent, the colt is out of a half-sister to Ruby Slippers, dam of champion sprinter Rubiano; he was purchased by Bradley & Bowden, LLC, as agent for Guy Snowden after working one furlong in :10 4/5 Sunday. "The colt was a homebred from (Mr. Lakin & Sons)," said Becky Thomas Montgomery of Sequel Bloodstock. "He was originally part of the Saratoga Yearling Sales last August, but his owner thought enough of him to buy him back for \$135,000. There has been a really strong market for \$250,000 horses at this and other two-year-old sales, and we felt that this colt was at or near the top of that market." Hip #12, a half-sister to Horse of the Year Holy Bull, was bought back for \$135,000; she was one of 27 two-year-olds, 31 percent of the 86 hips offered, which failed to reach their reserves. A total of 59 two-year-olds sold at Calder yesterday evening, bringing \$4,711,000; the gross was down 11 percent from a year ago, when 65 horses went for \$5,302,000. The '96 average of \$79,847 was down just 2 percent from the 1995 average of \$81,569. The final session of the two-day auction begins today at 12 noon.

SERENA'S SONG PROBABLE FOR BIG 'CAP

Serena's Song (Rahy) worked a bullet six furlongs in 1:12 1/5 at Santa Anita Monday, and owner Bob Lewis said yesterday that "everything points to her running" in Saturday's \$1 million Santa Anita H. "I think Bob is about where I am on this thing," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas yesterday. "He wants to make sure if we run that it won't compromise the rest of her season. But she's a sound filly and a durable filly...she's special. This Big 'Cap, even without Cigar, is a little better than we've seen the last few years. I want to sit down and look at the race objectively because I haven't paid all that much attention to the handicap horses around here." If she was successful, Serena's Song would become the first of her sex to win the Big 'Cap.

COBRA KING PREPS FOR FLORIDA DERBY

Cobra King (Farma Way) worked a mile in 1:40 at Gulfstream yesterday as he gets ready for his next start in the March 16 GI Florida Derby. "I was happy with the work," said trainer Mike Puype. "He went the last quarter in :24 2/5, so he finished up good...it lays a good foundation for the Florida Derby." As for the competition he will face from Saturday's Fountain Of Youth runners, Puype said, "They are good horses, but Cobra King will be ready to run and he will be the horse to beat."

OJC INVOLVED IN LABOR DISPUTE The Ontario Jockey Club, without a contract with mutuel workers since their two-year agreement expired December 31, 1995, has locked out its mutuel clerks. The lockout began Monday at 11 a.m., in advance of the scheduled 1 p.m. simulcast card from Gulfstream. The mutuel clerks set up picket lines at Woodbine, Mohawk, Fort Erie, Greenwood and the OJC's Teletheatres in response to the lockout; they are disputing the OJC's decision to switch to paying by the hour instead of by the daily shift. The OJC has trained its non-union employees as replacement workers. Some 700 clerks are affected by the lockout, which is believed to be only the second in the OJC's history.

SANTA ANITA H.-GI, \$1,000,000, 4yo/up, 10f

Trainer Ted West, who saddled his only prior Big 'Cap runner, Interco, to victory in the 1984 edition, has taken over the conditioning of **Luthier Fever** (Mt. Livermore). "It was kind of an accident," said West. "My exercise boy and assistant, Rafael Castaneda, knows the owners (Alfonso and Jose Antonio Lanzagorta), and he called them and recommended me." The six-year-old shipped to West's Santa Anita barn Sunday afternoon. **Mr Purple** (Deputy Minister) worked six furlongs in 1:14 3/5, handily, at Santa Anita Monday, while supplemental nominee **The Key Rainbow (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest) went the same distance in 1:13 2/5 at Hollywood. Trainer Rodney Rash said yesterday that he may send **Urgent Request (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest) to Florida for the GI Gulfstream Park H., also March 2. "We could get him on a plane Thursday morning and get him to Florida, where they're talking about rain this weekend," said Rash of the grey, who wired the field in last year's Big 'Cap.

Ide (Forty Niner) makes his three-year-old debut this weekend. The Pete Vestal trainee rides a five-race winning streak into the Southwest; he ended his two-year-old season with wins in the GIII Iroquois S. and GIII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill Downs. Regular jockey Craig Perret is expected to ride.
