**NEW RECRUITS FOR DUBAI WORLD CUP** The retirement of **Freedom Cry (GB)** (Soviet Star) and the defection of **Mahogany (Aus)** (Last Tycoon {Ire}) due to a throat infection have prompted the Dubai World Cup panel to invite Britain's **Needle Gun (Ire)** (Sure Blade) and American **Dare And Go (Alydar)** to take part in the \$4 million event March 27. Needle Gun's Newmarket-based handler Clive Brittain was thrilled to hear the news. "The horse is extremely well. I would hope that Brett Doyle, who is currently riding in Dubai, will be available to take the ride," he said. Richard Mandella, trainer of Dare And Go, stated, "I am honored. I hope he will run a big race at Santa Anita (today), and I am looking forward to Dubai." Mandella will also saddle **Soul of the Matter (Private Terms)** for the World Cup.

**HALLING RETURNS** Halling (Diesis {GB}), top-rated four-year-old in Britain last season, makes his return to racing in a 10-furlong conditions event at the Nad Al Sheba sand track in Dubai Sunday. The hero of last year's G1 Eclipse S. and G1 Juddmonte International but a disappointment when eased in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic in his final start of the campaign, the Godolphin color bearer is preparing for the \$4 million Dubai World Cup March 27. Halling is a perfect three-for-three over at Nad Al Sheba; he will carry highweight of 133 pounds Sunday with jockey Frankie Dettori in the irons. His four rivals are G1SW **Torrential (Gulch)**, **Zillion (Fr)** (Darshaan {GB}), **Dahik (GB)** (Green Desert) and **Jandeel (Ire)** (Last Tycoon {Ire}).

**SAM HOUSTON OPENS TODAY** Sam Houston Race Park's 1996 Thoroughbred meet begins today and runs through Friday, June 7. Stakes schedule highlights include the \$75,000 Texas Thoroughbred Association Derby at 1 1/16-miles April 27; the \$50,000 Sam Houston Distaff at 1 1/16-miles May 27; the \$50,000 Maxxam Gold Cup at 1 1/8-miles June 1; and the \$35,000-added Texas Thoroughbred Association Sales Futurity with divisions for colts/geldings and fillies at five furlongs June 7.

"The Internet and a new computer awareness are bringing electronic communications within the grasp of everyone...and the great advantage is that the Internet is on call 24 hours a day, 365 days a year," said Roger Shook, vice president of Registration Services at The Jockey Club. "Eventually breeders should be able to complete virtually all registration procedures electronically."

It will be no problem to get Danewin ready for the Cup with the facilities which are available out there." The Australian champ is scheduled to fly to Dubai March 8.

The highly-regarded D. Wayne Lukas-trained three-year-old Dr. Caton (Seattle Slew) will try to break his maiden in the \$100,000 Foster City S. at Bay Meadows this Saturday. The event, for three-year-olds at a mile, has drawn a field of nine. In his career debut Feb. 4 at Santa Anita, Dr. Caton finished third in a 1 1/16-mile maiden special weight. The \$325,000 Keeneland July yearling will be making only his second lifetime start in the Foster City S. "I know it's a big step and I don't normally do this, but I think if he's going to make an impact on the Triple Crown races we better give him a better test than just a maiden race," explained Lukas.
