RODNEY RASH DEAD AT 36 Trainer Rodney Rash, 36, who was to saddle defending champ Urgent Request (Ire) in today's GI Santa Anita H., died Friday morning at Los Angeles' Midway Hospital of complications from a rare blood disorder. Rash had been admitted to the hospital Tuesday with what was believed to be a severe case of the flu. His death came as a shock to family, friends and the racing community; it was attributed to a rare disease known as Thrombotic Thrombocytopenic Purpura, which affects the central nervous system and stems from unknown causes. A native of Maryland, Rash joined the Charlie Whittingham stable at the age of 16 and worked his way up to chief assistant before taking out his trainer's license in 1991. During his five years of training, Rash saddled 143 winners for earnings of \$8,707,331. Funeral arrangements are still pending.

SHIRLEY HEIGHTS SET FOR COVERING Shirley Heights (GB) (Mill Reef), the 1978 Epsom Derby winner whose life was twice threatened by colic in January, will begin to cover mares again within two weeks. The 21-year-old stallion needed two operations on his intestines and, at one stage, it was feared he might have to be put down. But the 1978 Horse of the Year in England and Champion Three-Year-Old Colt in Ireland has made such a speedy recovery that Michael Oswald, Royal Studs manager, has begun to make plans for a test mating. "He has made extraordinary progress," Oswald said. "He is exercising every day and eating everything we put in front of him. We shall try him on a mare in around two weeks and, if all goes well, arrange to find four or five more for him to cover and take it from there." Shirley Heights has sired 48 stakes winners and the earners of over \$12 million.

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown

From the perspective of a professional horse player, having horses to bet against is just as good as having one to bet on, and there are a couple of bad favorites in today's Big 'Cap. **Afternoon Deelites** (Private Terms) was a dynamic two-year-old, but has never progressed a step. In his last start, when he should have gone forward, he actually went back a little. **Helmsman** (El Gran Senor) ran a figure of 4 1/2 in his Strub win, but has never run a race good enough to win this at the weight.

On the other hand, **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene) gets a pound from the heavyweight, his average race is slightly better than Helmsman's, and his best race (2 3/4) is much better. And what is the story with **Serena's Song** (Rahy)? Gender allowance notwithstanding, how can this gal get in with 114? At these weights, her average race may win, and her best race (2 1/4) leaves these in the dust. We don't regard her races at the distance as definitive--they came at dubious points in her form cycle and she's run too many big ones at nine furlongs.
