**BIG 'CAP WRAP-UP** Mr Purple (Deputy Minister), who was 300-1 to sweep the MGM Grand Classic Crown, is now the only horse eligible for the \$2 million bonus after Saturday's upset victory in the GI Santa Anita H. The four-year-old now heads for the second leg of the Classic Crown, the \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup June 30. The point standings for the \$500,000 Participation Bonus for the MGM Grand Classic Crown are: Mr Purple, 10; Luthier Fever (Mt. Livermore), 7; Just Java (Java Gold), 5; Helmsman (El Gran Senor), 3; and Cezind (Ferdinand), 1. Serena's Song (Rahy), seventh after putting a head in front on the far turn, came out of the race in good order and will likely ship to Oaklawn for her next start. "She's fine," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "She's got a sixth sense about her...she knows how to take care of herself. We haven't completely ruled out the Santa Margarita (March 10), but she'll probably go in the Apple Blossom (April 12)." The filly, six-for-six at Santa Anita going into Saturday's race, suffered her first loss at the track in the Big 'Cap.

**HALLING SHARP IN RETURN** Halling (Diesis {GB}) had no trouble beating his four opponents in a mile-and-a-quarter conditions event at Dubai's Nad Al Sheba racecourse Sunday and is now all set for the March 27 Dubai World Cup. The Godolphin five-year-old, with Frankie Dettori making up most of the 133 pounds on his back, was always going easily after a good break and, under only a hands-and-heels ride, drew well clear after entering the home stretch to score by seven-and-a-half lengths over Torrential (Gulch). The British champion is now undefeated in four starts over the track.

**NORTHERN SPUR PREPS FOR PAN AMERICAN** Northern Spur (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) worked six furlongs in 1:15 at Santa Anita yesterday morning as he gets ready to make the trip east for the GII Crown Royal Pan American H. at Gulfstream Saturday. Chris McCarron was in the irons for the breeze, and will fly to Florida for the Pan American. "Everything went smoothly," said trainer Ron McAnally of the work. "He went the last eighth in :12 and he didn't turn a hair. He was a little short (when fourth in the GII San Luis Obispo February 19). Getting a horse ready to run a mile and a half after three-and-a-half months off is not an easy task. But we were pleased with his effort and he got a lot out of the race." Northern Spur will fly out of California late Monday night and arrive at Gulfstream early Tuesday.

Tychonic, who won back-to-back claimers for \$80,000 and \$100,000 last August, ended his '95 campaign with a pair of listed stakes wins in November and December, then came back January 21 to take a third, winning the Reb's Policy at Santa Anita. Looking to keep the stakes streak alive while moving up to graded company, the bay was sent off the 2-1 second choice and did just that, shadowing 8-5 ROMARIN (BRZ) (Itajara {Brz}) through three-quarters in 1:10 3/5 before forging to the front and outgaming Debutant Trick to the wire. "He's gotten really, really good, especially when you consider how fast they went," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "I dropped him in for a couple of tags because he's not the soundest horse. Nobody took him and it's worked out well." Added winning jockey Gary Stevens, "He is so confident right now, he thinks he is unbeatable." Frankel indicated that Hollywood's \$700,000 Shoemaker H. at a mile June 16 will be the long-range goal for Tychonic. Trainer Richard Mandella said of the favorite, Romarin, who tired to be sixth, "(Jockey Corey Nakatani) said he was making some noise on the backstretch, so we're going to have to scope him and see what happened."

**JAPANESE JOCK TAKES YOUNG JOCKEYS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP**

Nosing out American John Velazquez, jockey Minoru Yoshida came on to finish second in the final race in the series and take the fifth Young Jockeys World Championship at Nakayama Race Course by a scant two points. Twelve jockeys from North America, Europe, Oceania and Japan, age 27 and younger, took part in the four-race event, which was held March 2-3. After three races, Velazquez held a seven-point lead in the standings, but Yoshida managed a second-place finish in the final test while Velazquez could do no better than sixth, and carried the day for the home team. American Joe Bravo took home third-place honors in the Championship; Velazquez and Bravo had finished one-two in the first race of the contest, and two-one in the third. The rest of the Championship field, in order of finish, were: Tetsuzo Sato, Hiroyuki Uchida, Katsuharu Tanaka, Yutaka Take, Sarah Campbell, Thierry Thulliez and Jason Weaver and Pat Smullen (tie), and Masayoshi Ebina.

### Local News: Sportsman's Park

Starting today, there will be eight live races during weekday programs at Sportsman's Park instead of the normal nine. The format change is the result of an agreement between the track and the Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association in response to the short fields at the current meet, which began February 16. Extreme cold weather immediately preceding the meet and the large number of horsemen who have remained at Gulfstream, Fair Grounds and Oaklawn rather than shipping to the Illinois track are the factors cited as having caused the horse shortage. When the Sportsman's Thoroughbred population increases, 10-race programs will be carded to make up for the lost races. In the mean time, Sportsman's will continue to have nine races Saturday's and Sundays and the full-card simulcasting schedule remains the same.

### Local News: Fair Grounds

Trainer Bradley Cathey accomplished a rare feat March 1 when the two horses he saddled for the day's fifth race dead-heated for the win. Cathey's **Doug's My Doc** (Sweet Candy {Ven}) (\$3.00) and **Prodigious One** (Zuppardo's Prince) (\$5.80) finished up on even terms in the six-furlong sprint for \$15,000 claimers.

Three-year-old **Mackie** (Summer Squall), winner of the GIII Busher S. at Aqueduct February 25, will make her next start in the GIII Fair Grounds Oaks March 16. The regally bred filly, a half-sister to five graded stakes winners including Kentucky Derby victor Sea Hero, was purchased for \$550,000 as a Keeneland November weanling. She is named for trainer Elliott Walden's mother, Margaret, who is nicknamed Mackie.
