STAR-STUDED BARRETT'S SALE

BEGINS TODAY The seventh annual Barretts March Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training begins today with a stellar cast of juveniles scheduled to go through the auction ring. Catalogue highlights include a half-sister by Mt. Livermore to Saturday's GI Gulfstream Park H. winner **Wekiva Springs**; a half-sister by Capote to Saturday's GIII Southwest S. winner **Ide**; a full-sister to GI Met Mile winner **Dixie Brass**; a half-brother by Danzig to leading sire **Gone West**; a half-brother by Dixieland Band to Grade I winners **Star of Cozzene** and **Matty G**; a full-brother to MGI-winning sprinter **Twist Afleet**; a half-sister by Explodent to Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Desert Stormer**; and a full-sister to **Afleetaffair**, winner of the Feb. 10 GIII San Vicente S. Overall, 274 two-year-olds will be offered during the sale's two sessions, which will be held today at 2 p.m. and tomorrow night at 7 p.m. in Pomona, California. Woodman leads all sires in number of juveniles offered with nine. Jerry Bailey Sales Agency, agent, represents more two-year-olds than any other consignor with 27. Two of the last three Breeders' Cup Juvenile winners came through this sale--Brocco in 1993 and Unbridled's Song in 1995. During last year's event, 160 horses sold for an average of \$132,175, the highest average of any two-year-old sale in the nation. In addition, the three highest-priced juveniles sold at auction in 1995--El Paso Danzig (Danzig) for \$900,000, Seeking Regal (Seeking the Gold) for \$750,000 and Handy Dancing (Gone West) for \$725,000--were all sold at the Barretts March Sale.

FLORIDA DERBY CONTENDERS BREEZE Unbridled's **Song** (Unbridled), second in his first two starts of the year, breezed three-quarters in a bullet 1:14 yesterday morning as he takes aim at the GI Florida Derby March 16. "He was real relaxed today," said trainer Jim Ryerson. "He went the last quarter in :23 4/5. He can impress, especially when he goes easy the first part." Runner-up to longshot **Built for Pleasure** (Homebuilder) in the GII Fountain Of Youth S. last out, the colt was a handful while being saddled before that race. He has already schooled in the paddock once since the Fountain Of Youth, and is scheduled for three more lessons before the Florida Derby. Ryerson added the the Wood Memorial at Aqueduct April 13 could be Unbridled's Song's final prep for the Kentucky Derby. **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), also pointing to the Florida Derby, worked five furlongs in :59 3/5 at Gulfstream Monday. "He went super," said trainer Nick Zito. "He couldn't be doing any better. I'm pretty confident. Jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard for the breeze, will be back in the saddle for the Florida Derby.

THREE CHARGED IN STALLION SCANDAL

Paris police have charged three men in connection with the purchase of five stallions by France's National Studs. Two bloodstock agents, Alain Decrion and Crispin de Moubray, are charged with fraud. Michel Henochsberg, former chairman of the French Breeders' Association, faces the lesser indictment of conspiracy to fraud. The charges have been made as a result of a probe into the proposed purchase of Brier Creek, Calling Collect, Chatoyant, Epaphos and Hawker's News. All the deals were handled by Decrion, but were officially blocked after it was discovered that the Studs were being asked to pay a combined total of \$380,000 more than the vendors.

FAIR GROUNDS RAISES STAKES PURSES

New Orleans' Fair Grounds has increased purses for 11 stakes races for the second time during its '95-'96 meet. Fair Grounds President and General Manager Bryan Krantz announced the increases Monday. The March 17 Louisiana Derby purse will go from \$350,000-guaranteed to \$350,000-added. The \$250,000 New Orleans H. and \$150,000 Fair Grounds Oaks will receive corresponding increases, moving from guaranteed to added status. The Explosive Bid, Bayou Breeders' Cup H. and Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. purses have been increased to \$150,000-added. Five races, the Harry Allsman Memorial H., Battler Star H., Victoria Lass S., the Gentilly H. and Red Camelia H., have all been increased by \$15,000 to \$75,000-added.

STEEPLECHASERS RETURN TO SUFFOLK

DOWNS Suffolk Downs will host steeplechase racing for the first time in 27 years when the jumpers return to the East Boston oval for four races as part of the Massachusetts H. weekend program, May 31-June 2. "We're really trying to create a festival-like weekend for the MassCap," said Vice President of Racing Lou Raffetto. "These races should add excitement...while bringing a classic style of racing back to Massachusetts."

Last year's Arkansas Derby winner **Dazzling Falls** (Taylor's Falls) came back from Sunday's Oaklawn allowance victory in good shape and will make his next start in the \$150,000 Razorback H. March 16.

Jockey Garrett Gomez, who left racing last summer because of personal problems, has been issued an Arkansas jockey license and will soon resume his riding career. Winner of the Gill Arkansas Derby the past two years, Gomez was third in the Oaklawn standings last year. "I have been living in Little Rock and undergoing therapy for alcohol abuse," he said. "I intended to start back riding when Oaklawn opened this year, but I had let things get too far out of hand. But I'm really getting that good feeling back. I need to shed another 10 pounds, something I don't foresee as a problem."

A. V. Eight (Wavering Monarch), winner of three stakes last year including the Gill Bashford Manor S., has just completed a four-month treatment program after contracting Equine Protozoal Myelitis last fall. The three-year-old has run once this year, finishing a subpar sixth in the Mountain Valley S. at Oaklawn February 10 after a four-month layoff. "He looks and acts good," said trainer Bob Holthus. "Right now about all we can do is train him and monitor his progress. I still have hopes of making the Bachelor S. (April 9) with him."

Jockey Don Pettinger, injured in a spill January 19 at Oaklawn, returns to action at Remington Sunday before going back to Arkansas for next Wednesday's card at Oaklawn.
